INTRODUCTION

The civil parish of KILVELLANE lies in the barony of Owney and Arra at the extreme south of north west Tipperary and on the border of Co. Limerick.

The parish name has faded almost into obscurity having being replaced in Church of Ireland usage by 'The Union of St John, Newport'. The total acreage, per the 1851 Census, is 8,678 acres. The village of Newport is the largest centre of settlement within the parish.

In the Church of Ireland division Kilvellane is part of Killaloe Union. It is part of the modern Catholic parish of Newport-Birdhill which lies in the Archdiocese of Cashel and Emly.

There are two graveyards in the parish:

The oldest, that at <u>BALLYMACKEOGH</u> (down a road to the left off the Newport to Limerick road) has the substantial remains of the parish's old church built from attractive red sandstone in a picturesque location near the Mulkeir river and close to the former home of 'Ryans of Ballymackeogh' - a prominent Protestant branch of that very prolific Kilvellane surname.

At the time the inscriptions in this publication were transcribed the graveyard was very overgrown and was the most difficult to compile of all the graveyards examined during the Society's ongoing project.

It contains about 126 gravestones that have been transcribed and possibly more that could not be located by the compiler but may surface in any future clean-up. There is also a very large vault on which no name or other identifying mark could be found though a person living locally thought it belonged to the EGAN family.

A number of the stones date from the middle 1700s and early 1800s. The two oldest being a memorial to CHARLES RYAN who died in 1730, followed by one to a MARGARET FITZGERALD alias BOURKE who died in 1741. Another early one commemorates a Fr. DAN CONNELL who died in 1751 aged 84, though it does not state if he was a priest of the parish.

There are about 30 stones dedicated to various members of the RYAN family dating from 1730 to the present day. A number of stones were broken or badly weathered and where it was found impossible to read a word it is recorded thus: ---. If the date is uncertain it is recorded thus: ?1830 ?1850, with the more likely date first.

The Newport area had a very substantial Protestant population in the 18th and 19th centuries. There was a church in the parish of Killoscully and in the village itself.

ST JOHN'S GRAVEYARD, as it is known locally, is a small, neat area located in the grounds where the parish's Church of Ireland church stood until demolished in 1962 because of a diminished congregation.

This church must have been quite old since an entry in the Parish Vestry Book recorded in 1783 "that the Parish Church of Newport being much out of repair, the churchwardens employ proper persons to repair it". A steeple was added to the church in 1821.

There are only 29 gravestones in this graveyard. The most interesting perhaps being a large vault, erected by SIR ROBERT WALLER to the memory of his lady, who died alas in 1804". Sir Robert himself died in 1826. There is another large vault nearby with no identification other than a rather elaborate coat of arms. It is believed to contain the mortal remains of a Dr Carey of Limerick. Though the church possibly dated from the middle 1700s, none of the stones are so early. Apart from Lady Waller, the oldest is a memorial to a Joseph Carey who also died in 1804, followed by the Anderson family from 1806. The others are fairly modern.

Also included in this publication are transcriptions from the wall tablets, ground slabs, tomb and celtic cross in the grounds,, and from the various plaques and stained glass windows within, the R.C. CERCH, NEWPORT.

This Romanesque-style church was built in 1933. Its predecessor was sited down a lane off the main street and dated from 1795.

Obviously the priests' memorials which pre-date 1933 were removed to here from the interior or exterior of that old church which still stands having served as a parish hall for many years.
