DID YOU KNOW ?

* Although the County Board declared Fethard the first county football champion in 1887 yet for some reason Templemore were allowed to represent Tipperary in the All-Ireland Championship of that year.

* In 1920 Fethard brought the last All-Ireland Senior Football victory to Tipperary. In that year they beat Mullinahone in the final, which began one hour late because of the late arrival of both teams.

* Between 1917 & 1924 Fethard won seven county finals in a row, no final was played in 1921. The following players took part in these memorable victories: Ned O'Shea, John O'Shea, Ned Cummins, Gust McGrath, Jer. Phelan, Ned Connolly, Tom Tubridy, Jim Gorman, Tom Hogan, Jack Delaney, Mick Gunn, Con Fitzgerald, Dan Mullins, John Weston, Jack Brett. Reserves: Tom Mackey, Dick Mackey, Tom Conway.

* In 1934 Dick Allen was the first Fethard man to be picked on a Munster Senior Football team and wore the royal blue jersey of Munster for the next six years.

* The 1955 County football final, in which Loughmore-Castleiney beat Arravale, was played at Cashel.

* When Loughmore-Castleiney defeated Fethard in the 1983 final at Cashel the victorious side was: J. Kiely, T. Ryan, M. Kiely, S. Fogarty, P. Treacy, M. Meagher, E. Brennan, G. Stapleton, T. McGrath, M. McGrath, P. McGrath, J. Cormack, P. Brennan, J. Treacy, M. Walsh.

* Eddie Webster was a regular on the county senior football team and was on the successful Division II National League win in 1971. In the same year he was on the Munster Railway Cup team that lost the final but played on the successful teams of 1975 & 1976.

* The ball was thrown in by the famous Bill Ryan Laha (R.I.P.) in the 1987 county football final played at Cashel.
