Baxter's Literary Journal (9). For the subsequent career of Baxter after his Nenagh paper collapsed, see Co. Louth Archaeological Journal, 1947, 178-179.

Cashel Advertiser (4). The GPA Bolton Library, Cashel, possesses Nos. 1 to 4, dated Sept. 1861, Oct. 1861, Nov. 1861 and Dec. 1861.

Chun an Lae (4). The National Library of Ireland has one issue, the NLI ref. being Misc. Periodicals LB 05 Ml. For a history of the paper, see *Recollections of the Fight for Irish Freedom*, by Seán Fitzpatrick (Tipperary, 1975), pp. 68-70, where the author states that the machine used to print this paper was still extant in the early 1970s. The Editor of the *Tipperary Historical Journal* can confirm that it was still extant in the Summer of 1990.

Mary Immaculate College, Limerick, has the following micro-films: Clonmel Advertiser (1828-1838, & 1843); Nenagh Gazette (1841-1842); Nenagh Guardian (1878-1899); Tipperary Constitution (1835-1848); Tipperary Leader (1855-1885); Tipperary Nationalist (1889-1890).

Nenagh Tribune. From April 1981 to December this paper, printed and published by the Midland Tribune, had an office in Nenagh.

Templemore Telegraph. The full title of this paper, was *Templemore Telegraph and Mid Tipperary Commercial and Agricultural Advertiser: Nenagh News, Thurles Times & Roscrea Record!* The only known copy, dated March 3, 1900, is in the possession of Mr. Paul Walsh, Templemore.

CORRECTIONS:

Nenagh Guardian (8). In line 2, Clonmel Herald should read Clonmel Advertiser; in line 3 '1857' should read '1851'.

Tipperary Leader (10). The heading should read *Tipperary Leader* (1855), and the date in line 2 should read '27 January 1855'.

Index (16). For Carrick Democrator read Carrick Democrat; for Clonmel herald read Clonmel Herald; for clonmel Journal read Clonmel Journal.
