Journal of Cork Historical and Archaeological Society: an Index to Tipperary Material 1892-1991

Introductory

Cork Historical and Archaeological Society — there is no definite article in its title — was founded in June 1891, and the Society's Journal (in this Index referred to as "JCHAS") was first published in January 1892. With only one break — in 1923 because of the disruption caused by the Civil War in Cork — the JCHAS has appeared continuously for over a century, it being assumed that the volume for 1992 will have appeared by the time this Index is published.

For the first 5 years or so of the 101-year life (so far!) of the JCHAS it appeared monthly. From the July-September 1897 number it became a quarterly publication, and so remained for another 21 years. From 1919 to 1982 it appeared at half-yearly intervals. Since 1983 it has been published annually, a change principally caused by the vagaries of that creature of European Community bureaucracy, the VAT system.

In June 1897, in one of those claims that may strike the outsider as characteristic of Cork, the remit of the Cork H & A Society was blandly extended from the city and county of Cork to the "South of Ireland generally" — apparently without consultation with those in the last-mentioned area. (One assumes, not without some risk of error, that by "South of Ireland" those in charge of the Cork H & A Society in 1897 meant the rest of Munster rather than the four provinces excluding Ulster!) However, as this Index demonstrates, material relating to the more remote parts of Munster (as viewed from Cork) had been appearing in the JCHAS from the start.

Explanatory

To mark the century of the JCHAS in 1992 the committee of the Co. Tipperary Historical Society decided in 1991 to compile and publish an index of Tipperary material in the JCHAS. The compiler of this Index disclaims any expertise in indexing. The method he adopted was simply to go through each volume of the JCHAS noting each appropriate item, that is, any contribution relating to a person or place in the Premier County, or one written by a native of that county, or any reference (no matter how brief) likely to be of interest to readers of the *Tipperary Historical Journal*.

Each entry in this Index specifies merely the year of publication of the relevant volume of the JCHAS and the appropriate page-number. Apart from having the obvious merit of simplicity, this means that the Index spares its users the inconvenience of trying to master the crazy numbering system of the JCHAS, necessarily used in the various indices (of which more later) of the JCHAS. (Anybody taken aback by the use of the adjective 'crazy' is invited to peruse the paragraph headed "Numbering" in the informative article by the present editor of the JCHAS in its Special Centenary Number (1991), at page 61.)

Miscellaneous

Some minor points remain to be made regarding this Index. Where a personal name only appears, it may be assumed that it refers to a native of Co. Tipperary. Similarly, where a placename only appears, it is one of a place in Co. Tipperary. However, a few such placenames, whose location



could not be ascertained by the compiler and which do not appear in the official Townland Index of 1861, have been omitted.

Cross-references are few and far between. Reviewers of books in the JCHAS who are, or may be, natives of Co. Tipperary are not included unless they appear also elsewhere as contributors. This omission was discovered at a late stage by the appearance as reviewers of Dr. E. Shee Twohig of UCC and Ms M. Cahill of the National Museum of Ireland. (The former, incidentally, is indexed only under her maiden name.)

Full sets of the JCHAS are to be found in the Cork City Library, the Cork County Library, and the Boole Library in UCC, and (in Dublin) in the National Library of Ireland, the library of the Royal Irish Academy and the Berkeley Library in Trinity College, Dublin. Four indices to the JCHAS have been published — Volume 1 (1892-1940); Volume II (1941-1960); Volume III (1961-1970); and Volume IV (1971-1985), published respectively in 1943, 1964, 1976 and 1990.

The compiler, who was not short of advice from colleagues in the Co. Tipperary Historical Society not prepared to compile this Index themselves, is grateful for assistance and comments received from Dr. Denis G. Marnane (Tipperary), Liam O Duibhir (Clonmel), and Daniel Grace (Nenagh). However, for any errors or omissions he is himself wholly to blame. Notice of errors or omissions will be welcomed, and recorded in a later issue of this Journal.
