In his "History of the United Irishmen" Madden relates that 2 miles west of Ballyporeen, the north Cork Militia under the Earl of Kingsborough, were skirmished and held up for 2 days, when on their way to Wexford in 1798. There is no evidence of the existence of United 'rishmen here. Neither is there any local tradition regarding the engagement. I was therefore unable to establish anything additional or in support of Madden's Statement, in the time at my disposal.

SPAS OR MINERAL SPRINGS.

In the extreme south-eastern corner of Tipperary, where it adjoins Cork, Limerick and Waterford, lies the Parish of Ballyporeen. Bounded on the north by the Galtees and on the south by the Knockkealdowns, it covers the western portion of the great valley dividing these Ranges.

As would be expected the scenery is delightfully varied; the quaint easy going countryside, through which the little river Duag pursues its winding course on its way to the Suir: the bare wind-swept moors of the Knockmealdowns to the south: the terraced, evergreen-wooded, slopes of the Galtees in the north; and dominating the whole panarama Galteemore (3015') towers majestically against the northern sky.

GEOLOGY.

Mitchelstown caves on lands of Mrs Mulcahy of Coolagarranroe Ballyporeen. $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles due north of Ballyporeen $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles south-east from Skeheenarinka junction on the main Cork-Cashel-Dublin road. By far the largest caves in those Islands, - Mitchelstown caves were accidentally discovered by quarrymen in 1833. They were completely explored, and surveyed by the French Speleologist, M. Martel in 1895. Mr. Mulcahy will act as guide. And for the modest sum of 1/6 the tourist can spend an interesting day exploring immense chambers and tortuous passages for a mile and a half underground. There are numerous rock-formations - stalagmites, stalactites etc., and Mrs Mulcahy will point out the Houses of Lords and Commons, Speakers Chair, Kingston Gallery and many other finds. Finally there is the "Enchanted Stream" over which nobody returns. Mrs Mulcahy relates the story of the old fiddler who had the temerity to cross over, and he will direct your attention to the sound of the fiddle still playing in the unchanted distances beyond.

A couple of hundred yards away, on the lands of Mr. Denis English, is the entrance to the "Old Caves", much more extensive in every way, but, so the experts say, geologically not so interesting as they do not contain the unusual rock-formations. The time of their discovery is unknown. They have interesting associations with Irish History. It was here that the "White Knight" of Kilbehenny placed his kinsman the "Sugán" Earl of Desmond, and their betrayed him, more than 300 years ago. It is also held locally, although not verified, that Geoffrey Keating was in hiding here while he was on the Run.

They have never been completely explored. Young makes a reference to their existence in his "Tour of Ireland".
