### BALLINGARRY ( C.of I.) GRAVEYARD

This graveyard surrounds the C.of I. church in Ballingarry, which place lies about 4 miles East by North of Borrisokane and in the Barony of Lower Ormond. According to Gleeson, the original church at Ballingarry was burnt down in the early 1500's during a feud between the O'Carrolls, when a number of persons who had taken refuge in the church burnt to death.

Ballingarry is in the modern Catholic parish of Shinrone. The Catholic church is at the Pike, where there is a small modern graveyard whose headstones have not been copied.

The graveyard at Ballingarry, which is very well kept, is considerably older than the present church. It contains many headstones dating from the early and middle 1700's. The oldest inscriptions belong to the Smith family. One Thomas Smith being born in 1666 and died in 1754, Mary Smith born in 1690 and died in 1710. According to Samuel Lewis, (1837), the Smith family owned lands at Lismacrory which later passed to the Bunbury family.

There is an interesting stone, unfortunately badly damaged, to the Lambe family, which was erected by a man describing himself as a citizen of the Great Republic of North America. There is a rather pathetic memorial to James Gregory aged 14 yrs. who was drowned in the wreck of the 'Tayleur'. This was an emigrant ship of 2000 tons, which left Liverpool on her maiden voyage bound for Melbourne, Australia. In a severe storm it was wrecked on Lambay Island in January 1854. Of the 576 people on board 250 were saved but they included only 2 women and 1 child out of the 200 women and 5 children on board the ship.

There are several headstones of the Trench family of Sopwell Hall. All the headstones that could be located have been copied. Many were buried and were dug out to be read, it is possible that other buried stones have been missed. The memorials within the church have also been copied. Where it proved impossible to read any portion of the inscription it is recorded thus -----. If the reading is doubtful it is recorded ?age22 ? 25. A few conventional religious texts have been omitted.

SADLEIR

9. Sacred to the memory of Thomas Sadleir Esqr and Margaret Watson, his wife. The latter died Augt 1817 aged 41 years. The former 22 Octr. 1842 aged 68 years. He was eldest son of Thomas Sadleir Esqr of Castletown, Barrister at Law, who was sole male representative of Thomas Sadleir



9. Esqre of Sopwell Hall and his wife Margaret Oliver of Kilmallock.  
'As in Adam, all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.'  
This tablet is erected by their children.
10. Sacred to the memory of their eldest son, Thomas Sadleir, J.P., High Sheriff of this County in 1859. He departed this life 15 July 1863 aged 66 years. His ashes rest with theirs in the Sopwell burying place. This memorial of affection for his memory was raised by his only son, Thos. Owen Saunders Sadleir.

SHEPPARD

11. In loving memory of Captain Henry Sheppard, J.P., of Clifton. Late of the 67th Regiment, who died August 9th 1893. This lectern is presented by his sorrowing widow.

12. SMITH

Sacred to the memory of Ralph Smith Esqre of Milford, who died October 1813. Of Elizabeth Smith his wife who died November 1829.  
Of Rebecca Margretta Bernard, their daughter, who died at Lisbryan July 24th 1834 and of Thomas Smith Bernard Esqre. her son. Their remains, laid in the adjoining church yard, await a glorious resurrection into eternal life, through Our Lord Jesus Christ.

13. Sacred to the memory of the Captain the Honble Cosby Godolphin Trench of Sopwell Hall, who served in the Royal Dragoons, 1862..... 1876.  
Second son of the 2nd Lord Ashtown. Born 6th Jan 1844, died 9th Dec 1925.
