MONSEA GRAVEYARD

This graveyard is in the civil parish of Monsea and in the townland of the same name about eight miles from Nenagh. It is in the modern Catholic parish of Puckane and Carrig. The Catholic parish register dates from the year 1834.

The church was originally 12th century and was extensively repaired and refurbished in the 15th century. The remaining ruins of this church were recently cleaned by the County Council. In the course of this work, three headstones belonging to the Tumpane family, which had been missed by the present compilers, were unearthed and have been inserted as an addendum on the last page.

Near this graveyard, there used to be a Church of Ireland church, but it was demolished in recent years. The adjoining large house was the rectory of this church.

In all, 207 headstones have been transcribed. A large number of these date from the early and middle 1700 s. The earliest being that to John Tumpane who died in 1730.

Where it has proved impossible to decipher part of an inscription it is recorded thus -----. Where there is a doubt about the interpretation, usually as regards a date, it is recorded thus ?1805 ?1803 with the more likely date first.

DROMINEER GRAVEYARD

This small graveyard is located in the townland of Dromineer. It is pleasantly situated on an elevated site overlooking Lough Derg and contains the ruins of a church that predates the 12th century and still has a fine east window.

In the middle ages, Dromineer was a Norman manor owned by the Cantwell family. There are 38 headstones in this graveyard, 15 of them being memorials of the Slattery family.

In view of the antiquity of the site it is remarkable that few of these headstones date from earlier than the middle 1800 s.

Carrig Church: Built by the Revd. Joseph Downes, A.D 1833.
John Hanly, Architect.

This church of St. Mary in Carrig was built in 1833 when Father Joseph Downes was Parish Priest on the occasion of its sesquicentenary and after extensive renovations, this church was solemnly consecrated on 13th June 1983 by most Reverend Michael A. Harty, D.D. Bishop of Killaloe. The Parish Priest being Canon John Henry Meehan and the curate Reverend James MacInerney.

DOWNES

1. Sacred to the memory of the Revd. Joseph Downes for 14 years Pastor of the united parishes of Monsea and Killodiernan. Throughout a long and active life he laboured zealously in the sacred ministry. This splendid chapel and several others erected by him remain as lasting monuments of his piety and striking proofs of the desire which he evinced to promote the honour and glory of his Devine Master. He departed this life on the 13th day of March 1844 in the 75th year of his age. At his special request, this monument is erected to solicit the prayers of the faithful for the eternal repose of his soul. May he rest in peace. (Wilm Harding, Nenagh, Facit).
