INTRODUCTION

The United civil parishes of Dorrha and Bonahum lie in the extreme north of the barony of Lower Ormond in north west Tipperary. They are bounded on the east by Loughkeen parish and on the west by Lorrha. The parishes are separated from Galway and Offaly by the rivers Shannon and Brosna. The toal area of the united parishes is approximately 15,750 acres.

In the Church of Ireland division they are part of Birr Union.

Together with Lorrha civil parish they form the R.C. parish of Lorrha
Dorrha. This is a rare enough instance where the two pre-reformation

parish names have been preserved in usage.

Dorrha parish graveyard is a small tidy site in the townland of Graigue near the Pallas river. It is clustered around the Church of Ireland church built in 1832. In the grounds is the remains of the older parish church, set into the ruined wall of which is a beautifully carved inscription in Latin. It is to the memory of one BERNARD KENNEDY of Culross and his wife ELINDR who was a TUBMAN. He died in 1704 and though his age is not mentioned he must have been born in the middle 1600s and this makes it one of the earliest memorials discovered in this present gravestone transcription project.

There is a gap of 60 years to the next group of memorials: John Haughton 1761, John O'Kennedy 1762 and William Ferns 1765. This gap made the compiler wonder if other headstones could be buried under the church ruins. A search was made and nothing found but many heavy stones and rubble have fallen from the roof and walls and headstones may have been buried.

There are a number of memorials from the later 1700s and early 1800s, and then the dates are very scattered up to modern times as though, perhaps, the graveyard was only periodically in use. It boasts one centenarian, Patrick Daly aged 102 years, and two rather tragic stones - Cameron Eneas Quiller aged 27 was drowned skating on the Shannon in 1855 and James Willington who was killed at Gallipoli aged only 21.

All the headstones that could be located have been transcribed as have the memorials within the Church of Ireland church.

The second graveyard surrounds the ruins of Bonahum old parish church. It lies in the townland of Derry on the road between Rathcabbin village and Portumna. It contains a number of stones from the 1700s, the oldest being a memorial to TIM LIKE who died in 1740. The most interesting inscription is a memorial to one who apparently was the predecessor of the modern District Nurse - ELIZABETH WELSH, who died in 1811, having attended to the groans of the aged and the cries of the newborn'

Very Rev. John Gleeson, P.P. of Lorrha and Dorrha up to his death and author of 'The History of Ely O'Carrol' recounts in that book that WILLIAM BONAHUM'S surname (see page 10) was really HAVERTY. The story, preserved in folklore and told to Fr. Gleeson, is that William changed over to Bonahum after an incident in 1798 when he hid in the ruined church from searching soldiers and was, he believed, protected from capture by St Ruadhan.

Where it has proved impossible to decipher part of an inscription it is recorded thus: - - -. Where there is doubt about the interpretation, usually as regards a date, it is recorded thus: ?1796 ?1790 with the more likely date first.
