CIVIL PARISH OF BORRISOKANE

There are three graveyards in the old Civil Parish of Borrisokane. The headstones in the large cemetery at the south-western entrance to the town date only from the 1920's and those in the grounds of the new Catholic church are all very modern. As these stones are easy to read and are all well documented, they are not included in this publication.

The old Catholic church was built in 1837, when the population of the town was 2,653, and is no longer in use as a church. The monuments of five priests were transferred to the grounds of the new church and these have been copied. There were also some burials in the grounds of the old Workhouse of Borrisokane. Only one of these has a headstone. This is included with the five stones transferred from the old church, otherwise all the monuments in this publication are in the grounds of the Church of Ireland church in the centre of the town.

The C.of I. church was built about 1812. It contains some interesting memorials, mainly to the Stoney family, one of whom was born in 1677. There is also a large vault belonging to this family in the graveyard of the church.

The church is surrounded by a graveyard containing about 100 headstones some of which are very old and a few in poor condition. There are 10 Kennedy monuments with dates ranging from 1720 to 1841 and 9 to the Meara family ranging from 1780 to 1853. There are a number of vaults belonging to the Cornwall family of Rathinore which are now rather badly weather damaged, also an unusual monument to a Sir Robert Ledger.

Some of the headstones are badly weathered or broken. An attempt has been made to decipher all of them but in a few instances the words have proved too difficult to decipher and these words are indicated thus————. Where a reasonable guess can be made, the doubtful words are shown thus ?1805 ?1808.
