BYRNE

3. Erected by Peter Byrne of Carney in memory of his father Michael Byrne who depd this life August 18, 1855 aged 61 yrs. Also his beloved mother Mary Byrne who died May 16th 1867 aged 71 yrs.

CARTY

4. Erected by Daniel Carty in memory of his father John who died February 17-4 aged 58. Also his mother Mary Carty alias Holmes who died April 2, 1765 aged 60 yrs.

CLEARY

5. Erected by Andrew Cleary in memory of his wife Bridget Cleary alias Donovan who departed this life March the 5th 1806 aged 45 years. Also his son Michael Cleary who depd this life August the 4th 1796 aged 20 years.
6. Erected by John and Michael Cleary in memory of their father John Cleary who departed this life January 15 1831 aged 63 years.

COEN

7. In loving memory of Mrs. Vina Coen, Johnstown, died 12 Jan 1946. Her husband Patrick died 26 Dec. 1949. Their sons, Christopher died 12 Nov. 1950 aged 31 yrs. Matthew died 2 July 1981 aged 65 yrs. Mrs. Kathleen Coen died 14 Sept. 1952 aged 32 yrs. (buried in Lisboney).

31. Erected by Edmd. Gaynan for his son Patk. Gaynan who died Feb 1805 (?1800) aged 19 yrs.
32. Sacred to the memory of Edward Gaynan who died on the 17th day of March 1842 aged 22 years.

2. To the loving memory of John Robert Headech Esqr. Johnstown Park, Nenagh, died 23rd May 1904 and of Elizabeth, his wife, 2nd daughter of Joshua Robert Minnitt Esq. Annabeg, Nenagh, died 7th May 1919 and of Robert Joshua Minnitt Headech their 2nd son died 11th April 1908.

HOLMES

3. Sacred to the memory of Lydia Waller Holmes died 28th day of June 1856 at Malahide aged 74 years, relict of the late . Rev. Dean Holmes. Francis Saunderson Holmes, Major in the 8th (or King's) regiment, died at Kurrachee 3rd August 1848 aged 38. Peter Holmes, Lieutenant in the 44th Madras Native Infantry, died at Maryalore in India, 26th September 1833 aged 22years. Alexander G.B. Holmes, Lieutenant in the Royal Navy, died at Port Royal, Jamaica, 16th Sept 1839 aged 26 years. Lieut. Hardress Robert Holmes, 66th Regt., died at St. Ann, Barbados, 29th Sept 1848 aged 25 years.
4. To the beloved memory of Rose Elizabeth, daughter of W. Bassett Holmes of St. David's & wife of Arthur Pollok died June 4 1923. EGAN

1. Sacred to the memory of Revd. Con Egan for 16 yrs the zealous enlightened administrator of these united parishes. In him, his mourning people have lost a saintly and beloved priest, a wise counsellor and a never failing generous friend. Possessed of private means, he bestowed it all in charity, this church and that of Carrig was largely renovated by his bounty. Died 1st Oct 1907 in the 69th year of his age and 45th of his sacred ministry.

HURLEY

2. Sacred to the memory of the Revd John Hurley, 21 years P.P. of this Union of Monsea and Killodiernan, who departed this life on the 17th day of Dec 1829 in the 53rd year of his age.

MALONE

3. Sacred to the memory of Rev. Eugene Malone P.P. Broadford for 11, Killodiernan & Monsea for 27 years. Died 3rd Dec A.D. 1875 in the 73rd year of his age and 49th of his priesthood.
