ST. KIERAN'S C.OF I. GRAVEYARD. MODREENY

Two graveyards in the parish of Modreeny, that adjoining the C.of I. church at Modreeny and that adjoining the disused R.C. church at Gawn, together with the small number of memorials within the C.of I. and R.C. churches in Cloughjordan, are transcribed in this publication. The third graveyard in the parish, that adjoining the R.C. church at Cloughjordan, being of modern date is not included.

The C.of I. church at Modreeny is situated in the Barony of Lower Ormond about 2 miles from Cloughjordan on the Borrisokane road. It was built in 1822 in the grounds of the ancient church of St. Kieran. Of this ancient church only the northern gable and a small portion of side wall remain. It was designated a special place of pilgrimage by Pope Paul V in 1607.

All denominations use this graveyard and there is a modern extension just outside the walls of the older part. It had not been intended to transcribe this section but inadvertently approximately 20 headstones from this modern section are included.

Many of the original Cromwellian planters are buried in Modreeny, including John Harrison and his wife Elizabeth. A priest of Penal days, Fr. Darby Egan, who died in 1747 was buried here, also many of the Protestant clergymen and Methodist ministers who laboured in this region in the last century. The earliest headstone is that of Elizabeth Harrison who died in 1689, closely followed by Thomas Trench who died in 1690. Amongst the memorials within the church, is one to Sergt. James Somers, who won a Victoria Cross in the Gallipoli campaign during the first World War.

This graveyard is very overgrown in places and some of the headstones appear to have been placed one on top of another at some period in the past, possibly when the church was being rebuilt. It is thus difficult to be certain that every stone has been recorded. The compilers, while making every effort not to miss out a headstone, cannot be certain that they have succeeded.

When it proved impossible to decipher a part of an inscription, the missing words are indicated thus ----- . When a date is uncertain it is recorded with a question mark ?1805.

5. In loving memory of Joseph Armitage, Towra, Cloughjordan, died March 1897. His wife Sarah died Nov. 1900. His son John died Sept 16th 1938. His granddaughter Eleanor died Jan 11th 1925. His grandson Joseph died May 6th 1944. His daughter Helena died 15th Sept 1957. John's wife Eleanor died 11th July 1963. 'With Christ which is far better.'

Also his daughter Elizabeth Goulding died Aug 18th 1820 aged 18 years. And dear friend dry up your tears, here we lie till Christ appears, and when He comes we hope to rise unto a life that never dies.
73. Erected by William Goulding in memory of his father William, who died July 6th 1868 aged 57 yrs. Also his mother Eliza who died Decr 17 1892 aged 60 yrs. In loving memory of William Goulding who died 5th July 1945.
74. Erected by Elizabeth Goulding in loving memory of her husband William Goulding of Hilton who died 22nd August 1903 aged 40 years. Also their child, William Endicott Goulding died 20th August 1903 aged 6½ years. Also of his beloved wife Elizabeth died 31st Dec 1950 aged 84 years.

GREEN

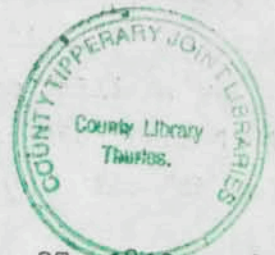

82. Sacred to the memory of Robert Hall Esq. of Merton Hall, County Tipperary who fell asleep in Jesus at Lisalea, Blackrock, April 3rd 1861 aged 52 years.

83. Here lies the body of Bridget Hanny alias Gleeson who died March 15 1791 aged 54 yrs. May she rest in peace. Erected by her husband Patk Hanny.
84. Sacred to the memory of Mrs Grace Hannay, of Wigtown N.B. who died at Cloughjordan 22nd Octr 1857 aged 64. This stone was erected by L.T. & G. Waugh. 'Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his saints.'

HAROLD

- Erected by Elizabeth Harold in loving memory of her beloved husband
85. William Harold, died March 5th 1905 and her son Robert Harold died March 25th 1890. Richard Holmes Harold died July 12th 1897. Also her son in law William Johnson died May 4th 1900. 'And with the morn those Angels faces smile, which I have loved long since and lost a while.'

HARRISON

90. Underneath lieth the body of Michael Head Esquire of Modreeny, a Lieutenant General in his Majesty's Service. Who after a lingering illness departed this life on the 11th of December 1827 aged 61. His afflicted widow has caused this stone to be erected over the precious remains of one of the best of husbands. Also in memory of the above Elizabeth Head, who departed this life on the 1st April 1864 aged 82, and was laid by her sorrowing son beside him who she loved so well.

91. In loving memory of William Edward Head, late Capt. R.A., Mount View, Rathvilly, Co. Carlow, dearly loved husband of Dora Head and eldest son of the late William Henry Head, Derrylahan Park, Birr, died 5th June 1945 aged 81 years. Also his beloved wife Dora died 11th Aug 1952 aged 76 years 'Call me not dead, my soul to Christ has fled and soon both soul and body joined shall be.'

HODGINS

GRAWN GRAVEYARD

Grawn graveyard is situated in the townland of Coolnamuna, Barony of Lower Ormond and is about one mile north west of Cloughjordan. The ruined church was described by Samuel Lewis in 1837 as 'The chapel of Modreeney, a handsome modern edifice'. It was built in 1830, as an inscription on the door still records, 'Omnipotenti Deo Sacrum, 1830. It was closed for public worship in 1936 and since then it has rapidly deteriorated into a ruin.

There are 5 priests' graves in this cemetery, 2 outside the walls and 3 within though one of these is unmarked. It is that of Fr. Daniel Smyth who died in 1888. The two Fr. Dunnes were an Uncle and nephew. They lived in a small thatched cottage near the church and were natives of Co. Offaly.

To the right of the entrance gate, in an unmarked grave, are buried the parents of Thomas MacDonagh, the 1916 poet and patriot. They were National School teachers in Cloughjordan village where Thomas was born in 1878.

Since the opening of Cloughjordan cemetery in 1936 Grawn is not much used. There is a local tradition that many victims of the famine are buried in Grawn, some in mass graves.

There are 51 inscribed headstones all of which have been copied. Due to a clerical error one stone, Dr Quigley, is out of alphabetical order and appears under no. 51.
