INTRODUCTION

KILMORE civil parish lies south of Nenagh and contains about 13,500 acres. In the Church of Ireland division it is part of Nenagh Union. Kilmore, together with Ballinaclough and part of Dolla, form the modern Catholic parish of Silvermines.

The main graveyard is located in and around the substantial ruins of the old parish church situated beside the Nenagh to Silvermines road.

Amongst the early gravestones is a memorial to one Johana O'Brien alias Reidy, who died in 1731 at the age of 101 years. She was therefore born in 1630 and this is the earliest date recorded in the Society's graveyard survey to date.

There are several other stones dating from 1739 and 1740 and a number from the later part of that century and the early part of the 19th century.

There is a memorial to a Fr. Edmund Toohey, the parish priest of Kilmore who died in 1781. Henry Prittie, 2nd Baron Dunalley, Kilboy House, is also interred here.

There are 41 gravestones to various generations of the Gleeson family dating from 1759 to the present day. They are by far the most numerous name recorded in the graveyard.

Some of the stones are broken and others badly weathered and difficult to read. Where it has proved impossible to decipher a word it is recorded thus: ---- Where there is doubt as to the date it is recorded thus: ?1831, ?1851, with the most likely date first.

The inscriptions from the wall plaques and other memorials located in the grounds of the former parish church in the village of Silvermines are also included.

from the small wall-enclosed area beside the road and behind the church of Our Lady of Lourdes in the village of Silvermines. This was where the old parish church stood until demolished in the early 1950s. The wall plaques mentioned below were obviously preserved from the interior of that church.

The present church stands on the site of the parish's Church of Ireland church which was handed over by the Church Representative body to the Catholic parish.
