BALLINACLOUGH GRAVEYARD

The civil parish of Ballinaclough was a parish of 3,700 acres in Upper Ormond. It was once a Norman Manor associated with the De Marisco and Travers families. In Norman documents Ballinaclough is usually referred to as 'Weyperous or Vadum Petrous, 'Stoneyford.'

Within the graveyard are the ruins of a 15th century church. This is divided into a Nave and Choir and still has a fine limestone Chancel Arch. It also contains a mid-19th century Church of Ireland church, which was in regular use until about two years ago, when it was finally closed and a handsome stained glass window removed for further use elsewhere.

The graveyard falls naturally into two sections. An older rather unkempt section to the right of the entrance gate and a more modern section to the left. Within the ruins of the earlier church are many memorials to Kennedy families; on the floor is a monument to Samuel Bindon, whose death has been previously recorded as 1611, but in this compiler's opinion reads 1677. This is the oldest monument in the graveyard.

There are 96 inscribed headstones, allof which have been copied. A few of the stones are broken or badly weathered and the entire inscription cannot be read, in these cases the missing words are indicated thus -----.

Within the Church of Ireland Church are 13 inscribed tablets, mainly to members of the Bayly family . These also have been copied.

A short distance along the road is a modern Catholic church which has no gravestones within its grounds. There are two memorials inside the church and these have been copied.
