THE ~~CIVIL~~ PARISH OF NENAGH

The Ormond Historical Society has selected the civil parish unit as the basis for compiling the gravestone inscriptions.

The civil parish was a state administrative unit and was the smallest division of the Established Church (Church of Ireland). The modern Catholic parish of Nenagh is an amalgamation of the civil parishes of Nenagh and Lisboney. The present Church of Ireland Nenagh Union embraces the parishes of Nenagh, Templeberry, Ballynaclogh, Monsea, Killodienan, Kilbarron, Kilruane, Ballymackey and Kilmore.

There are three graveyards in the civil parish of Nenagh - Kenyon Street, the Franciscan Friary and St John's Priory, Tyone. Each will be published separately, as will transcriptions from Lisboney.

Portion of the civil parish lies in the barony of Upper Ormond and portion in Lower Ormond. The parish bounds as given in the Civil Survey of 1654 were ". . . beginning on the west and south with the lands of Ballycahill on the south by the lands of Bawne . . . on the east with the parish of Lisboney and Ballynacloghy . . . and on the north east with Grange in the parish of Knigh . . ." The boundary on the north was the "united parishes of Musea and Dromineer".

KENYON STREET GRAVEYARD, or Barrack Street, as it was legally described until 1965, is in Upper Ormond. It is distinguished by a fine square stone bell-tower which has the date 1700 inscribed on a stone in the eastern face (graveyard side) immediately below the capstone. There is documentary evidence that there was a church here "in a partly ruinous state" in 1615. A new church, incorporating the tower, was built in 1809 and was the Church of Ireland parish church until St Mary's, Church Road, was completed in 1860. The old building was then dismantled except for a small section which is still standing.

There are quite a few 18th century gravestones in the graveyard, the oldest being a flat ground slab commemorating "Shusana Heas. . . 1753." There are about ten uninscribed stones of varying heights and texture some of which may not be gravemarkers.

There are some stones, including an altar tomb, with the inscription totally obliterated by weathering. Some other inscriptions have been partially obliterated by weathering or vandals and are entered thus: "who departed --- Dec 17 ---". Conjecture or uncertain readings are shown thus (Eliz). I have also transcribed the name of the monumental sculptor when given and it is entered thus: Murray; Murray Nenagh; Harrison Dublin.

The late Edward H. Sheehan, M.B., compiler of 'Nenagh and its Neighbourhood', published some transcriptions from this graveyard in the 'Nenagh Guardian' of October 1936. In instances where words or dates are now illegible I have brought forward Dr Sheehan's transcription and indicated them thus: + given by E.H.S.

Kenyon Street is an interdenominational burial ground. Generally the gravestones are undecorated - I found only one (NO.3) with the 'Heraldry of Christ' (cross, ladder, flail, pincers, nails, cock in pot) carved on it. There are quite a number of polished slate slabs, some with beautiful lettering, and these have withstood the elements remarkably well.

Another interesting feature is the number of gravestones which were obviously made and inscribed by relatives or friends of the persons commemorated rather than by a monumental sculptor.

This graveyard is the resting place of many who were well-known citizens - O'Neill Quin, first Medical Officer of the County Gaol; Peter Holmes, the town's landlord; John Kempston, founder of 'The Nenagh Guardian; Sean T. O'Neill, Town Clerk; Mary Ann (Bab) Starr, Jubilee Nurse; Ned and Joe Hassett, All-Ireland handball champions.

The absence of names on "THE SOLSBOROUGH VAULT" (No 236) is because there was a complementary tablet in the church, see Nos 27 and 29 in part 2 of this volume.

Transcription of the inscriptions was made easier by the major cleanup programme carried out in 1977-8 under the auspices of Nenagh Urban District Council and Kenyon Street Cemetery Committee, when many flat grave slabs were uncovered and altar tombs and upright monuments stripped of ivy and other vegetation.

St Mary's Church is situated in the barony of Lower Ormond (the barony bounds being the Clareen stream which flows under Kenyon Street on the town side of the old market house). I have included transcriptions from its memorials with those of Kenyon Street graveyard in this Upper Ormond volume because some pre-date St Mary's (1860) and were obviously transferred from the old church in Kenyon Street and because some relate to persons interred in the graveyard itself.

St Mary's Church was completed in 1860, and consecrated in December of that year. The site was donated by a local man, Carrol Watson, whom E.H. Sheehan states was a Watson of Brookwatson. He was a barrister by profession and he died in 1860.

The design is Gothic with English plate tracery windows and the contractors were Messrs Hunter of Bandon, Co. Cork. The building gave its name to the road which subsequently developed from the narrow Grace's Lane which, pre 1860, extended from Summerhill to Grace's Street now St Flannan's Street.

The memorials form a most handsome set. All of the inscriptions are interesting because they are biographical records of the families who dominated the business and commercial life of Nenagh and district in a past era, and of the churchmen who served in the parish.

The oldest tablet in the church commemorates Mary Finch who died in 1678 aged 59 years. The latest is almost three centuries on - the memorial to Precentor Dermot Mahon Carmody, Rector of Nenagh parish from 1951 until his death in September 1966.

There are six stained glass windows in the church; all but the rose window in the organ gallery are dedicated. The one in the sanctuary is to the memory of Rev James Hill Poe, who was Rector of the parish when building of the church commenced but who died in 1859. The most beautiful one is undoubtedly that with the simple inscription: "Michael Kortright, aged 2 years". This was designed by the donor, the late Mrs Kathleen Kortright, and executed in the Harry Clarke Studio, Dublin, in 1971. The design reflects the donor's lengthy domicile overseas and particularly in the multi-racial territory of Miri, Borneo, where her son is buried.

I have also included the supplier's, sculptor's or artist's name where shown on the tablet or window. Though not recorded on the window itself newspaper reports of the opening of the church state that the Poe window (No 28) was supplied by Messrs Moore, London. A like source reveals that the Burr-Fletcher tablet (No 16) was executed by John Kirke, R.H.A., an eminent sculptor at that time.
