BALLYMACKEY GRAVEYARD

This graveyard is situated in the village of Ballymackey which is very clearly signposted on the main Nenagh to Toomevara road, some five or six miles from the town of Nenagh. It is in the townland of Cloonmore in Upper Ormond.

The graveyard is in two distinct sections, one, which is modern, surrounds the C.of I.church in Ballymackey and is in excellent condition, the second part, directly beside the first, is a large sprawling area, very much older and in poor condition. The ground in this section of the graveyard is uneven and overgrown and it is possible that some headstones have been missed. See note at the end of the transcriptions. All the headstones in both parts have been copied and are included in this publication as well as the memorials within the church.

This church replaces an earlier one which was apparently in the older churchyard. The Vestry records, which are still in existence, show that there was a church here in 1716 which was badly damaged in a storm in December 1814. A loan was subsequently raised from the Board of First Fruits in 1817 for the building of the present church which was built in 1820 on land donated by Henry C. Bowen.

There are a number of headstones dating from the 1700's the earliest being 1728. Amongst the headstones of interest are the Tolers of Beechwood, the family of the Earl of Norbury, and the Rev, Michael Philpott, rector for 40 years, his signature is clearly legible on the Vestry records from 1753 to the year of his death in 1798. He succeeded the Rev. Peter Wybrants who was Rector from 1734 to 1753.

The R.C. church for this area is in Ballinree, a few miles nearer Toomevara. It has a graveyard but the headstones only date from 1920's and have not been included in this publication.

Where it has proved impossible to read a part of an inscription the missing words or letters are indicated thus -----. On a few stones conventional religious phrases have been omitted. Where there is some doubt especially regarding dates it is shown ?1805 ?1815.

BALLYMACKEY GRAVEYARD

ANDREWS

1. Here lieth the body of John Andrews of Firmount in the King's County Esq. who dep. this life the 21st day of Oct in the year of Our Lord 1728 ? (could be 1798.)
2. Here lie the remains of Mrs. Mary Andrews, wife of Mainsell Andrews Esqr of Firmount, in the King's County, who lived beloved and died lamented in the 25th year of her age, July 12th 1793.
'Rest mortal earth beneath this marble stone, till Angels wake thee to become divine'.

Here is also buried his wife Eliza, who died on Easter Sunday, the 9th of April 1882. 'For so He giveth His beloved sleep.'

He lived beloved and died lamented on the 27th day of June 1796, having completed his 57th year on the day before his release from a long and painful illness, brought on by the death of his deservedly lamented only son.
149. Underneath this stone lieth the body of Daniel Minchin Toler, only son of Danl and Rebecca Toler. He was born on ye --day of Octr. 1768 and departed this life on ye 24th of Sept 1795. The ?heart rending afflictions of his parents can only be consoled by the blessed hope, that as their beloved son's conduct was that of a Christain, he has been found acceptable in the sight of his all merciful creator, in whose heavenly mansions he may now receive the reward of the virtue he practiced during 27 years probation in world. The Lord giveth him, the Lord hath taken him, blessed be the name of the Lord.

Afterwards the relict of Colonel Thos Whitney of Newpass in Coy of Westmeath who departed May 30th 1716 in the 62 year of her age.

This inscription is recorded in 'The Diocese of Killaloe' by the Rev Philip Dwyer, as being inscribed on a headstone in Ballmacket cemetery. The present compiler searched carefully over the whole area but failed to locate it. Neither did she find the grave of Morgan O'Meara, who died in 1829, the last O'Meare to have the title of Chieftain of his Clan, as recorded in 'Toomevara the unbroken Chain.' T. Boland. However many of the headstones lying flat on the ground were buried several inches deep and were with difficulty located, cleaned up and read. It is quite possible that both these stones have sunk many inches down, and the fact that they were not located may not mean that they are not, in fact, present, just that a careful search in 1982 failed to locate them.
