INTRODUCTION

The civil parish of AGHNAMEADLE lies in the extreme north-east of the barony of Upper Ormond. In the Church of Ireland division it is part of Cloughjordan Union. Most of the parish lies in the R.C. parish of Toomevara but a small part lies in Templederry-Kilnaneave R.C. parish.

The total extent of the parish is approximately 10,300 acres. The land was largely owned by the Magraths and O'Kennedys when the Civil Survey was recorded in 1654.

There are five graveyards in the parish: (i) In and around the Augustinian Priory ruins near the R.C. church in the village of Toomevara. (ii) In the ruins on an island in the village square. (iii) In the grounds of the Church of Ireland church in the village. (iv) In the grounds of the old parish church in the townland of Aghnameadle. (v) In the grounds of Gortagarry R.C. church.

The Augustinian Priory graveyard has the oldest marked burial - 1766. However Fr John Gleeson in his 'History of the Ely O'Carroll Territory' (1915) and Dermot F. Gleeson in his 'The Priory of Tuam Donain' (Molua 1940) refer to an O'Meara tomb with a ~~difficult-to-decipher~~ Latin inscription which mentions a William Meara and Ellen Bourke and the date 1644 (DFG) or 1664 (JG).

The Priory was a daughter foundation of Mona Incha, Roscrea. It ceased as a religious house after the middle of the sixteenth century and is named in a grant made by Queen Elizabeth I to Miler Magrath, Protestant Archbishop of Cashel. Fairly extensive remains of the foundation survive.

The burials beside the ruin on the island in the square are all 20th century ones. Present-day experts, who have examined the ruins, agree with Dermot F. Gleeson's 1940 conclusion that these ruins are non-ecclesiastical and therefore not part of the Augustinian Foundation. Gleeson suggests they may be 'the butt of a ruined castle with certain chambers thatched' mentioned in the Miler Magrath grant.

The Devaney brothers, James and Thomas, killed at Kilruane during the War of Independence in January 1921, are interred here.

Aghnameadle burial ground lies in the townland of that name. It is a substantial enclosure and slopes away steeply from road level towards the Ollatrim river. However burials marked with gravestones are confined mostly to the slope rather than the low-lying area though there are some there.

There are two ruins in this low-lying area. Firstly the old parish church of which little remains and which, unlike most graveyards, contains no marked burials. Secondly, there is a small empty oratory-style building near the foot of the slope with a stone-vaulted roof and interesting sandstone doorway.

The oldest gravestone dates from 1776 (no. 18). No particular name dominates - there are a few Kennedys and Meaghers but no Magraths.

The oldest marked burials in the vicinity of the Church of Ireland church date only from the 1840s. The church was rebuilt after destruction by fire in the 1920s and has no wall tablets or other inscriptions inside. Powell is the dominant name here and appears on 11 of the 17 inscriptions transcribed.

The majority of the gravestones around Gortagarry church are post 1950. The Stations of the Cross are all dedicated and these have been transcribed but alas they contain no dates.

All the gravestones and tablets that could be located have been copied. Where it proved impossible to read the whole of an inscription the missing words are indicated thus: - - -. If a date is in question it is recorded thus: ? 1850 ? 1856 with the more likely date first.

L The Latin is transcribed exactly from what seems to be freshly re-worked lettering and includes some spelling errors. More importantly, the date of death of Rev. John Meagher (1861, aged 75 years), P.P. for 40 years, which is known to be correct from other sources, could hardly have preceded that of his brother Rev. Patrick Meagher, S.J., to whose memory Fr. John erected the tablet; Fr Patrick's, given as 1879, might have been 1839 (he was aged 32) if an X was re-worked as L.
