THE CIVIL PARISH OF CASTLETOWN-ARRA

Castletown-Arra Parish in the barony of Arra and Owney contains four separate burial sites as follows:-

Castletown-Arra Graveyard - located on roadside near Castlelough Amenity Area.

Castletown-Arra Church of Ireland Graveyard - on roadside one mile past Portroe on main Portroe/Killaloe road.

Partroe Roman Catholic Church Graveyard - in Church grounds in Fortroe.

Garrykennedy Graveyard - beside road from Portroe to Garrykennedy.

The present volume contains all the inscriptions from the first three graveyards. As Garrykennedy graveyard has only been opened for the past few years the inscriptions in this graveyard have been omitted from this volume.

Castletown-Arra is now in the Catholic parish of Portroe. In the Church of Ireland parochial divisions it forms part of the Killaloe Union.

CASTLETOWN-ARRA GRAVEYARD

In the graveyard are the walls of a ruined church. This church was supposed to have been built on the site of the old Parish church. It is known a church existed on this site in the early seventeenth century. The present ruins are probably eighteenth century and measure approx. 60ft. x 30ft. The church was in use up to the middle of the nineteenth century when the new church in Castletown (just a short distance away) was built in 1855.

The earliest dated inscriptions found were N.K.-1724 (No. 58), Gason-1727 (No. 32) and Dwyre-1728 (No. 28) but probably the oldest surviving gravestone is the one erected by Terence Mac I Brien in memory of his wife Morine Carroll (No. 13). The inscription is in Latin but the dates are now illegible. Terence Mac I Brien died in 1601. His son, Moriertagh Mac I Brien, was Protestant Bishop of Killaloe from 1575 to 1612.

The most predominant names found in the graveyard were O'Brien, Seymour, Parker, Gleeson and Carroll.

The graveyard contains many examples of the art of the early stone sculptors. Many of the inscriptions are embellished with finely wrought designs and grave symbols and these must be worthy of further study.

CASTLETOWN-ARRA CHURCH OF IRELAND GRAVEYARD

The Church was consecrated on 3rd May 1855 and replaced the older church located a short distance away in Castletown as has already been mentioned.

The earliest inscription is 1860 and the predominant names are Koe, Parker and Smithwick.

PORTROE CHURCH GRAVEYARD

The Catholic Church in Portroe was built in 1872.

The earliest inscription is 1921 and the predominant names are McLoughlin, McInerney, Seymour, Ryan, McGrath and Gleeson.
