FENNOR GRAVEYARD

In April 1992 a notice appeared in the Tipperary Star inviting all who were interested in restoring Fennor graveyard to a meeting in Gortnahoe School. A group of thirty people attended and Richard Dunne set out in broad outline the plan to restore order to the neglected graveyard. A committee was formed and Canon Lambe gave it his blessing.

Soon Fennor graveyard became a hive of activity as tractors, diggers, cars and people all covered on the graveyard and set to work with shovel, axe and spade, wire brush and paint brush. Young and old worked together, initially two evenings each week, but as the dead line drew closer the pressure was on to have everything in pristine condition for the concelebrated Mass on August 31st.

The vastness of the area and its very neglected state made people feel that this was a mammoth task. Slowly, the graveyard began to take shape. Humps and hollows gave way to gravelled pathways and level green lawn. Headstones were once more legible and a job that many thought would take two years was completed within four months. This of course would not have been possible without the use of modern machinery. However, this is not to say that the job was completed without a lot of sweat and hard physical work and nobody knows that better than all those who worked so diligently and gave so generously of their time.

The open air Mass was the highlight of the project. It was concelebrated by Dr. Dornot Clifford, Dr. Morris, Fr. O'Rourke, Canon Lambe and many local and visiting clergy.

In May 1993 a further meeting of Fennor graveyard committee was held in Gortnahoe school. It was decided that there were a few necessary jobs to be taken on, like keeping the weeds in check, cutting the grass, painting the railings and organising litter bins. There was some discussion on flower beds and rockery but nobody then envisaged the Grotto that is now the focal point of the graveyard.

The Grotto dedicated to Our Lady is a testimony to the many members of the committee who worked week after week until the task was completed.

PARISH PRIESTS OF FENNOR

CASHILL, MATTHEW, PP Fennor, Boulick & Kilcooley, 1704. He registered in Nenagh, 11/07/1704, as pastor of the above parishes. He was then aged 60 and resided at Fennor. He was ordained at Longford by Dr. Edm. O'Reilly, Abp. Armagh on 06/09/1666. He died in or before 1712, in which year an Admon. Bond re his goods was perfected (IER, 1st. series, xii-518); Index of Admon. Bonds, 1644-1858 in PRO, Dublin. Probably he was PP Gortnahoe parish four years previous to 1704.

BUTLER, EDMUND, PP Gortnahoe & Urlingford 1743-65.

A priest of the diocese of Ossory. Appointed PP of Boulick, Fennor and Kilcooley about 1743. By arrangement between the bishops of Cashel and Ossory, he was also PP of Urlingford and Grane at the same time; priests from those dioceses alternated in the parishes mentioned. He was appointed to the prebend of Killamery in Ossory, 28/04/1764, and died 07/06/1765. It is said that he was killed when his horse took fright at a woman throwing water out her doorway. (See Carrigan, ii-379; Rev. Wm. Healy, *Transact. Ossory Arch Society*, vol. i) Visitations, Abp. James Butler, 06/07/1752 (*Visitation Book*, p.82); 22/07/1754 (p.147-8); 13/07/1758 (p. 161) - O'Dwyer, *Arch. Hib.* 1975. Only one chapel in parishes (in Cashel) that of Boulick, dedicated to Assumption; parts of chapel roof stripped by storm; other parishes are Kilcooley (ded. St Bernard) and Fennor (ded. unknown, ? Nativity of BVM); has collation granted Abp. C. Butler about 1743; uses a chalice belonging to Franciscan friars of Thurles; some vestments to be burned; will keep register of births, marriages, deaths; one school-master, John Butler. Visitation, 1758, Gortnahoe, apparently a newly-built chapel, school-masters John Butler and Derby Ryan; keeps a register.

(O) *RYAN, PHILIP*, PP Gortnahoe c. 1765-1805; and Urlingford 1776-1805 Dean.

He is said to have been a native of Rathbeg, Gortnahoe, and to have lived there as a pastor. He was educated on the Continent, probably subsequent to ordination. When he took the Oath of Allegiance, 1781/2, he gave his residence as Rathbeg, his age as 48 (sic), his parishes as Kilcooley, Fennor and Boulick, and stated that he received Holy Orders at Thurles, 25/07/1755 (*Arch. Hib.* i-76). His tombstone in Fennor reads: "Hic jacent reliquiae Phillippi O'Ryan, hujusce Parochiae quadraginta fere annos Rectoris, Decani necnon Diocesis Cassiliensis. Obiit decimo septimo Aprilis, anno (1805), aetatis suae 89 (or 80)". He is described as dean when paying Cathedraticum, 05/05/1800, but how long previously had he held that office, or who was his predecessor as Dean, has not been discovered. In 1776 he was appointed PP of Urlingford and Grane in Ossory, and he held those Ossory posts until his death while retaining his parishes in the Cashel Diocese. An Ossory priest, Edmond Butler, PP Urlingford, 1743-65, was also PP Gortnahoe at the same time; possibly it was considered equitable that a Cashel priest should enjoy the same parishes; after Dean Ryan's death this peculiar arrangement ceased. It is said that Dean Ryan's chapel in Gortnahoe stood on "Cashill's Hill" near Gortnahoe village, on the left of the road

leading to Urlingford. Fr. William Healy in "Transactions of the Ossory Archaeological Society", states that, according to tradition, Dean Ryan had as curates, Frs. Laffan and McKnight, the latter being CC in 1798. McKnight is Wm. McKnight (senior); Laffan may be Robert Laffan, later Archbishop, or John (Anthony) Laffan, OFM, who is found in Thurles in 1804. (See Carrigan: History of Diocese of Ossory, ii-379).

THE PARISH OF FENNOR

SITUATION. This parish is situated in the northeast extremity of the Barony of Slieveardagh in two detached divisions, the larger of which forms the northeast point of the Barony aforesaid and is bounded on the west by a detached portion of the Parish of Kilcooley and by the Parish of Moyne; on the northeast and east by the county of Kilkenny, and on the south by the Parishes of Boullick and Kilcooley.

NAME. This is the name of several Parishes in Ireland. The correct original Irish orthography of the word is Fionnabhair but it is here pronounced as if written Fionnuir. Colgan, though he often mentions places of the name, has no where given us his opinion of the meaning, but Jocelin, who is perhaps but a bad authority, translates it as Campus Albus. I find it generally applied to gentle hills.

The old Church of Fennor is situated on a hill about a mile to the west of the Town of Urlingford in the County of Kilkenny.

It is rather a rude building about four centuries old, but it would appear to have been remodelled since it was first erected. It is divided into nave and choir. From the choir arch to the west end measures fifty five feet but the western end is divided by a wall built across, which does not look original. The nave is twenty three feet, eight inches on the inside breadth. The choir, which looks exceedingly rude, is twenty one feet in length and nineteen feet in breadth. The choir arch is pointed and built of cut limestone in rather a neat style compared with the rest of the building and measures eleven feet in height from the present level of the ground and nine feet in width. the walls of this Church are two feet eight, eight inches in thickness and built in a rude style of masonry. There is a tombstone within the choir with a Latin inscription around its edges in the Blackletter character, which Mr. Du Noyer is requested to copy.

Immediately to the northeast of this Church is a high but slender fragment of the Castle of Fennor, said to have been built by the family of Turvin but now claimed by the Carrick family. Only a part of the north and west walls of this building remains, five feet ten inches in thickness and about forty feet in height.

The remains of the outer walls are also visible but they do not appear to be as old as the castle itself.

Turvin, the last heir to this place, is said to have lived in a house built at the foot of the castle about one hundred years ago.

In the townland of Urard (Oorard) in this parish, about half a mile southwards of the Town of Urlingford, are the ruins of an old castle called Caislean Dubh or Black Castle. Parts of its east and west sides remain and a fragment of its north wall but all the rest is destroyed. It measures sixty two feet from east to west and its extent in the other direction cannot now be ascertained. Its walls are four feet three inches in thickness.

The Field Name Book mentions an old church and graveyard on this Townland of Urard but I could not find them and the natives assured me that they do not exist. How then did they find their way into the Name Book?

In the Townland of Graigue-Padeen in this Parish are the ruins of another castle called Cloch na Cor-Ratha (Cloghnacortha) or Carey's Rock, and there is another in the middle of a bog in the Townland of Inchy-Rourke (O'Rourke's Island) said to have been built by the family of the O'Rourke's formerly located in this part of the County.

Fennor, a parish, 2 1/2 miles (S.) from Johnstown, on the mail coach road from Dublin by Cashel to Cork; containing 2073 inhabitants. The parish, which is bounded on the north and west by the bog of Allen and a small stream separating it from the borony of Eliogarty, comprises 5674 statute acres, which the exception of a considerable tract of bog, is chiefly under tillage. In the bog of Allen, and in this parish, is one of those verdant spots called islands, containing about 60 acres of excellent pasturage for sheep: the substratum of the island is limestone, but of almost every other part of the parish freestone. The small river at a very trifling expense, might be greatly improved by deepening the shallow parts, and thus afford a facility for draining the bog, and supply abundance of water for turning several mills upon its banks. Some limestone of a blue colour is worked for agricultural uses, but the general manure is a compost of lime and clay. Poyntstown, the property of Phanuel Cooke, Esq., is in ruins. Here is a constabulary police station. The living is a rectory, in the diocese of Cashel, forming the corps of the prebend of Fennor, in the cathedral of Cashel, in the patronage of the Archbishop: the tithes amount to £489.4.7 1/2. The glebe-house was erected by aid of a grant from the late Board of First Fruits; the glebe comprises 25 acres. The church is a neat modern structure, rebuilt by aid of a gift of £800 from the same Board, in 1815, In the R.C. divisions the parish is part of the union or district of Gortnahoe, or Boulick. About 250 children are taught in three public schools, of which the parochial school is aided by a donation of £10 per annum from the incumbent. The ruins of the old castles of Fennor and Graigue Padeen are in the parish, in which are also the remains of the old church, and several Danish rathis.

FENNOR

Fennor, also called Fynnor, has a long and interesting history. Records of its clergy go back to 1275, when William Okewe is recorded as being Vicar. We may presume that there was a church and, possibly a churchyard at that time. It would appear from the records that Fennor was an independent Parish, with its own vicar or Person, until 1302.

The Church, in thirteenth century Ireland was very different from that today. The Reformation had not yet occurred and much of the organisation and discipline that we take for granted did not exist. They were violent times; a time when many who held ecclesiastical positions were poorly educated and not overly diligent in what we would regard as normal duties of a priest; especially in the administration in the Sacraments and in the pastoral care of the people entrusted to their care.

During the time of William Okewe, it is said that the sexton violently assaulted and injured the Vicar of the Church. As a result the building was deemed profaned and the profaned and the Pope placed it under interdict; so that all solemn services and the administration of the Sacraments ceased there for a time. It appears that on investigation, the Archbishop of Cashel found that Okewe, himself, had struck a certain skinner (the sexton perhaps?) in the Church and drew blood, making it necessary for the building to be "reconciled"; a form of reconsecration performed after a period of penance or withholding of spiritual services in the church.

Okewe was succeeded by Maurice de Bree in 1299. He is described as "Parson," as was his successor, Henry O'Brogan 1301-1302. From this date the Rector or Vicar of Fennor was a Canon, the day to day administration of the Parish was usually conducted by a resident Curate, with the Rector residing elsewhere. In the case of Fennor this was not so. In Fennor the resident clergyman was the Rector, who was also Canon of Fennor.

We know that the Church and Chancel was in ruins in 1615. It seems likely that this unfortunate circumstance came about because of a long vacancy in the Parish. Early in 1607, William Flanagan, Canon, was deprived of the Living because he had leased the Living, which was then worth £24 a year, to one, Thomas Comerford, reserving £4 for himself. The Parish remained without any spiritual direction until John Lancaster, Bishop of Waterford, took control in 1610. It is unlikely that the Bishop actually conducted worship in the church and there is no record of him assigning these duties to another priest during those years. William Flanagan finally resigned in 1615 and Edward Warren M.A. was appointed to the Cure, by the Crown, on 14th. December 1616. Warren became Dean of Emly in 1621.

There may be another explanation for this vacancy. This was the time of the Archbishopric of Milar Magrath. A number of other Canons deserve particular mention. Ulysees Burgh M.A. also served as Precentor, or principal Canon with duties of Ardagh in 1692. Thomas Smyth D.D., his successor in 1693, served as Dean of Emly and Precentor of Clogher while at Fennor and became Bishop of Limerick in 1695. John Walsh became Canon in 1729 and died in office in December 1756. He is buried in Fennor Churchyard.

The Last Church on the site was built in 1815. This was taken down in 1878 and the materials were to have been used to build a Chapel-of-ease at Urlingford, so that the Parishioners might more easily attend worship. This building was never erected. The Church of Ireland was Disestablished by Act of Parliament in 1870 and a Reconstruction of the Irish Church was undertaken. In 1876, Fennor became part of the Union of Kilcooley and has been served by its Rectors since.

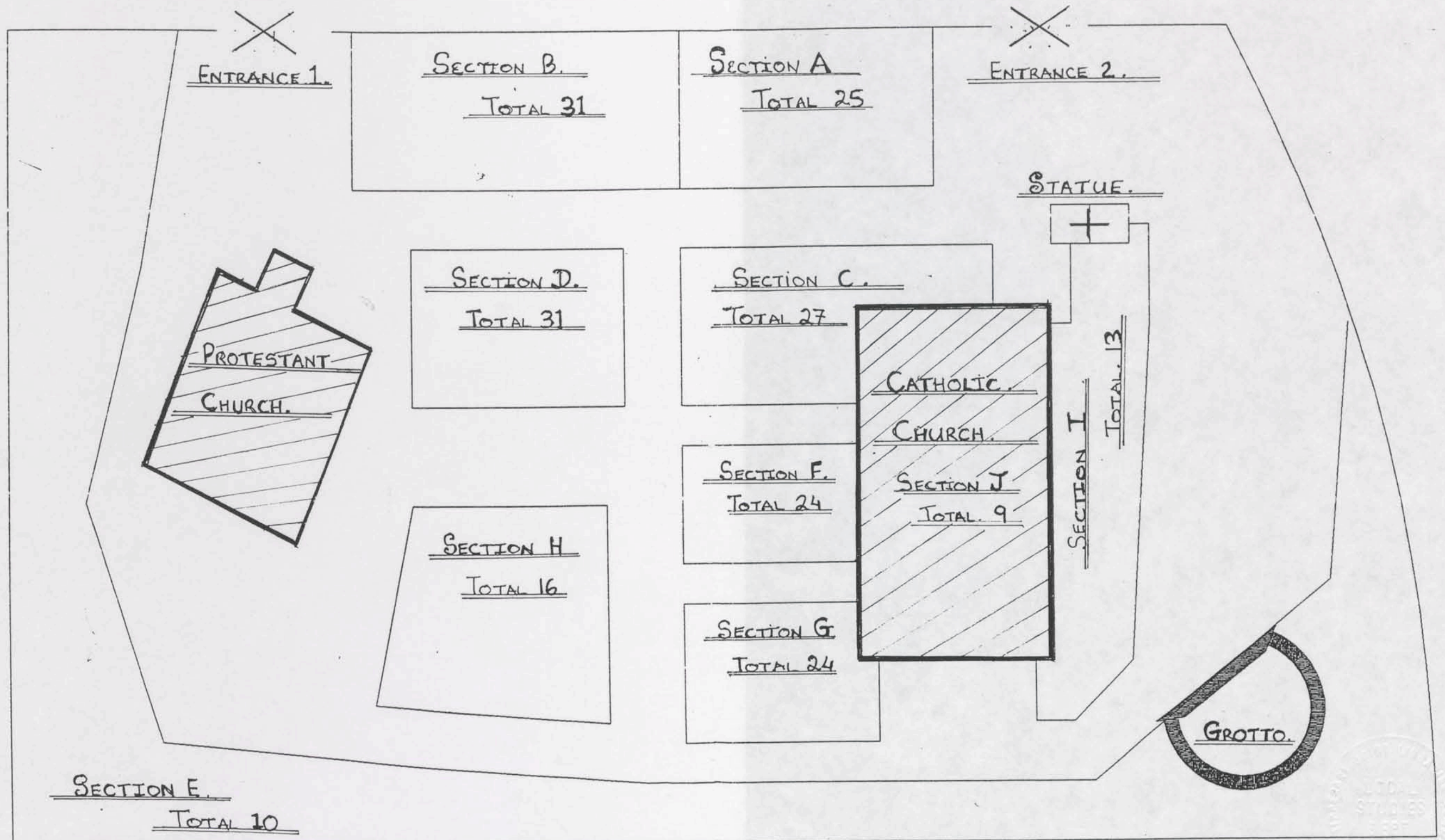
