Ardfinnan Football Club

Ardfinnan G.A.A Club was founded around 1907. In its early years the club did not achieve much success. In 1935 the club won its first senior championship and this was repeated in 1939. The sixties saw the club enter its most successful era with five South and three County titles. From 1968 to 1974 the club contested all county senior finals and won two. Current Laois manager, Babs Keating, played a starring role for the club in those successful years.

At juvenile level the club has been very successful having won South Championship in all grades and County Championship at U-21 and U-14. In 1993 the club won the All-Ireland U14 Peil na nOg competition and brought great honour and glory to the club. In 1995 the County U-16 title and the U-12 South Championship in 1996.

In 1983 the club purchased 6 acres of land and developed it into this playing field here today. A covered stand, four dressing rooms and car park were developed and were officially opened in 1988.

The field is now a credit to all concerned and in one of the finest in South Tipperary. Finally, we would like to thank all who have supported us here today and in the past.

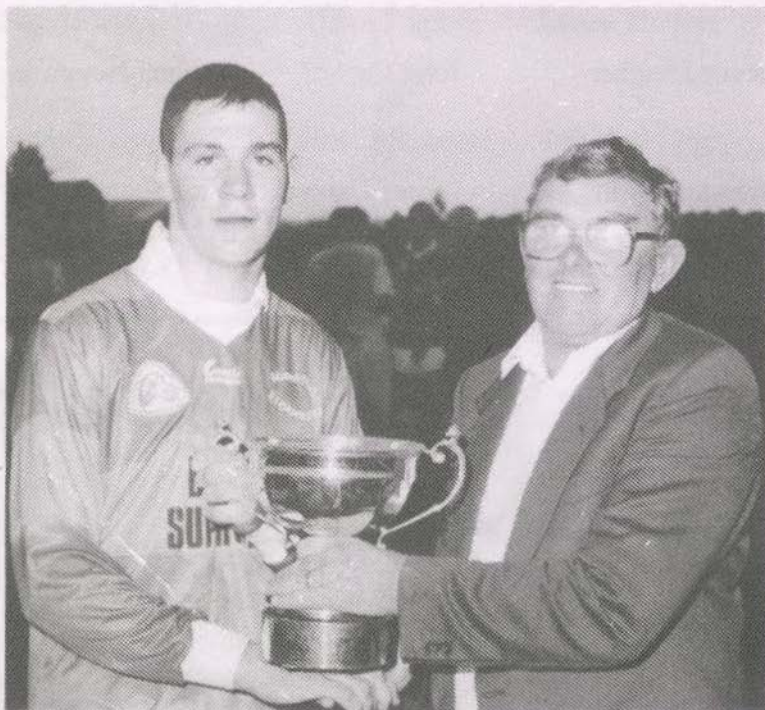

Inane Rovers

Founded in 1950 Inane Rovers Football Club has a very proud tradition. The club has won numerous North titles and three County titles. They won Junior County title in 1967, Minor A Title in 1969 and the Minor B title last year. Many of today's team were members of that victorious panel.

The club has provided many players for county teams. Three of today's team were on this year's county minors. John Carroll, Liam England and Tomas Carey while Aidan Sheridan was selector on that team. Enda Fitzgerald played on the Tipperary U-16 team which were beaten by Rens in the Munster Plate final. Others to represent Tipperary were Joe Dooley, Donie Ryan, Jer Tynan, Jack Pyne and Peadar Quealy. L. Dooley was a member of the Tipperary Minors who won the Munster Minor title in 1954. Peadar Quealy won an All-Ireland Football Medal with Cavan this year in the Over 40's. Under age football is very strong presently and north titles have been won in U-12, U-14 (3 in a row) and U-16. This with the success of the minor teams in 1995/96 augurs very well for the club. North Junior titlees were won in '92 and '93 and Intermediate finals were contested in '94 and '95.

Hopefully we can progress to Senior Grade in the next few years and win the County Senior Title. Inane Rovers contributed in a huge way to the St. Flannan's Combination which won three Senior County Titles in a row in 1959 to 1961.

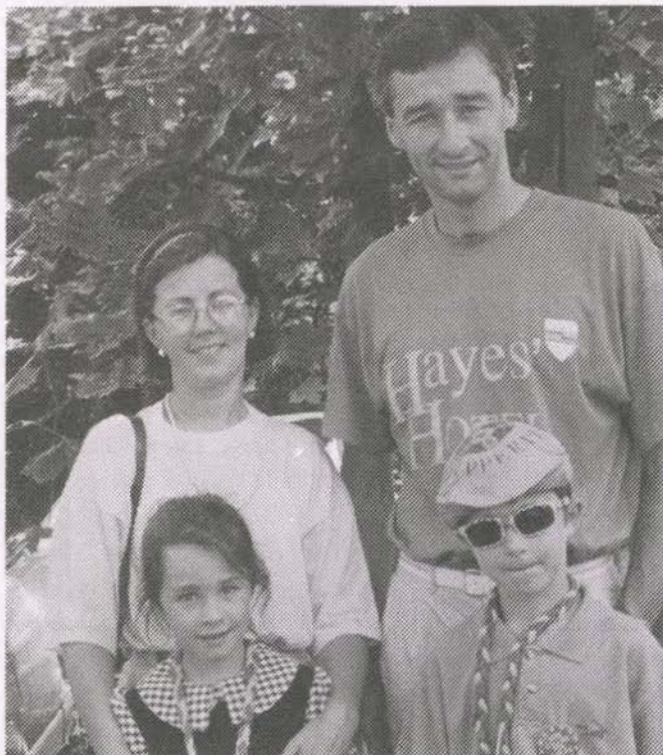
*Jimmy, a native of Moyne-
Templetuohy, received his
secondary education in
Thurles C.B.S. where he
won a Munster Colleges
Hurling Medal. During
his years at school and in
the early years of his
playing career with his
native club, hurling took
centre stage. However, on
joining the Defence
Forces after leaving
school and later while
attending college, football
became more than a
passing interest and
Jimmy became a constant
member of Tipperary
Senior Football team
from 1980 through to
1993.*

*During that period Jimmy
won County Junior and
Intermediate football
championship medals
with Moyne-Templetuohy
in 1979 and 1981 and a
County Intermediate*

Hurling Championship in 1983. In the late 1980's, while working in Dublin he played with Ballyboden St. Enda's who were beaten in the 1989 Senior Hurling Championship final by St. Vincents.

Jimmy also played with the Tipperary Junior hurling team for a number of years and was unlucky not to win a Munster Championship medal in that grade being beaten in two Munster finals.

To date Jimmy has won three County Football Championship medals at three different grades in three different decades, Junior in 1979, Intermediate in 1981 and Senior in 1995, which must be a record achieved by few. His experience on the playing field has been a vital factor in Moyle Rovers successes over the last few years and we look forward to many more years with Jimmy in the sky blue colours.

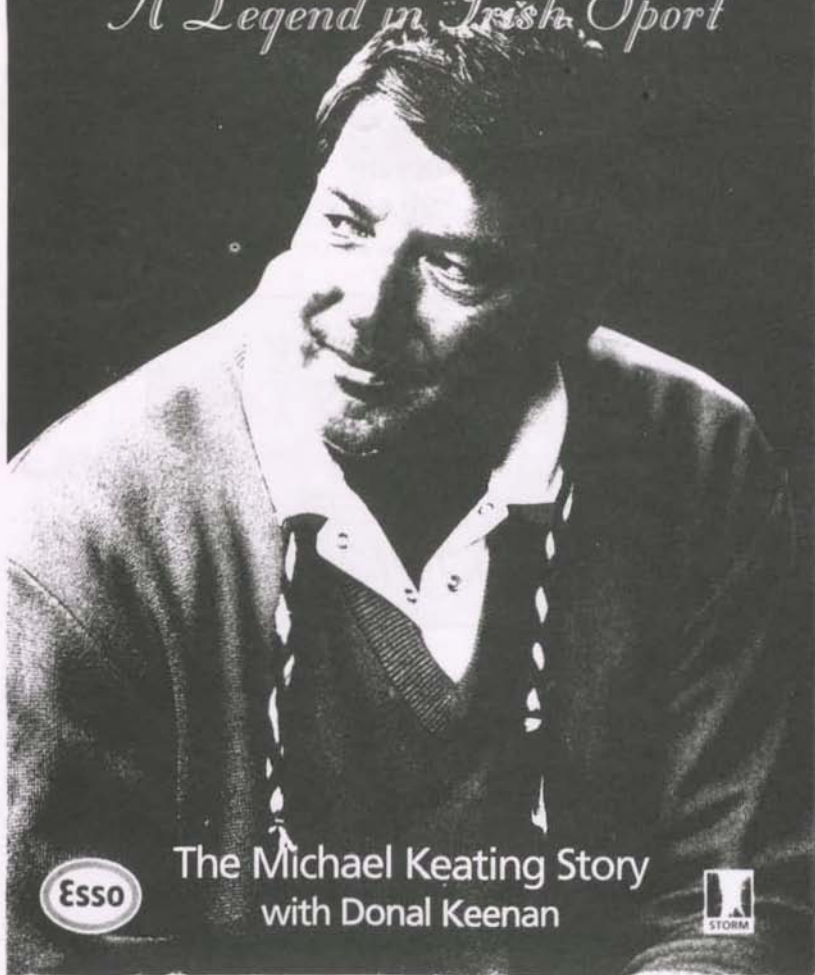
