Tipp Champs to face Claughaun

With today's County Senior Football Champions due to meet Claughaun in the Munster Club Championship at Limerick on Sunday next it will be of interest to recall the previous appearances of Fethard and Commercials in a championship that has never been won by a Tipperary team.

Commercials made their first appearance in 1965 a year after the championship was first inaugurated and they overcame Cooraclare by 1.8 to 2.3 at the Clare venue. This won them a place in the decider at Clonmel where, however, East Kerry proved superior by 3.7 to 0.7. In the following year Commercials defeated Kill at Clonmel by 1.6 to 0.8 but lost a cliff hanger of a semi-final to Cork champions St. Nicholas at Dungarvan. In 1967 Kill had their revenge on the Tipp champions when they beat Commercials by 0.9 to 0.6 in Dungarvan.

In 1969 Commercials scored a famous 3.6 to 0.11 success over East Kerry at Clonmel but lost to Claughaun 0.8 to 1.2 in the semi-final at Limerick. In 1971 Commercials again caused a major upset by accounting for Waterville by 1.7 to 1.6 in Waterville but went under to U.C.C. in the Final at Mitchelstown on the score 2.9 to 1.8.

The Clonmel side's most recent appearance in the competition was in 1982 when having defeated Stradbally by 1.11 to 0.4 they played a thrilling draw with Castleisland Desmonds in Clonmel (0.4 each). In the replay at Ardferth however, Commercials lost by 1.7 to 0.6

By comparison Fethard have been in action in this championship only twice. They made their debut in Kilrush in 1978 where they lost by 1.11 to 0.7. In 1984, however, Fethard scored a fine success over Claughaun by 1.10 to 1.6 and then put up a great performance before losing by 3.7 to 1.8 to Castleisland Desmonds.

Whatever the outcome of today's decider the Tipperary champions will be strongly fancied to at least reach this year's decider as the draw has ordained that should they succeed against Claughaun they will face the Waterford champions in the semi-final.
