

Today's 101st Tipperary County Senior Football Final is contested by Clonmel Commercials and Fethard, two sides who have proud records in the competition having won no less than 29 titles between them.

Fethard are seeking their 18th crown and although they'll start outsiders their challenge must be treated with the greatest respect. They'll remember that in 1988 they shocked Commercials in similar circumstances and they showed in defeating St. Patricks/Grangemeockler in last Sunday's Semi-final replay that they still retain much of the flair and ability that made them one of the leading sides of the Eighties.

Fethard will be hoping that players like Willie O'Meara, Michael Fitzgerald, Dermot Hackett, Willie Morrissey, Tommy Sheehan, Eoin Cummins and Michael Ryan can provide the inspiration and the leadership to undermine the challenge of the champions and bring "The Blues" their first title of the nineties.

Commercials have won the title on 12 previous occasions and will be hoping for a lucky 13th. They showed disappointing form early this year but their semifinal display against Moyle Rovers clearly signalled a return to their usual dominant style and they have a favourites chance of doing a three in a row for the second time in the history of the club. Indeed the Clonmel side are today contesting their 6th county final in a row surely a proud record and if such household names as Franny Kelly, Mark O'Connell, Joe McNamara, Donal O'Keeffe, Anthony Wall, Gene & Criostoir McGrath, John Kerin and Eddie Hewitt can perform to the best of their ability the O'Dwyer Cup should be annexed for the 13th time.

Whatever the end result an outstanding final looks in prospect however and may I echo the words of Co. Chairman Michael McGuire in hoping that wherever the honours rest at the end of the day — that Tipperary football will prove the real winner.


