The Commercials are seeking their fourteenth minor title on Sunday, 17th October, 1993, when they take on Newport in a first ever meeting at minor level for these two clubs.

Winners in 1992, Commercials are hopeful of repeating their successful efforts of 1954/1955 and 1967/1968 when they won two-in-a-row.

Quite a number of the panel were members of the 1992 title team which was captained by Liam Phelan. This year's team is captained by Ciaran Forrsital and Ciaran has as team-mates county players John McNamara, Neill Beckett, Brendan Walsh and Ollie Cahill.

Ardán Uí Riain in Semple Stadium is dedicated to the memory of Canon M. K. Ryan, who was born at Knockfune, Newport, in 1868. He was Chairman of Tipperary Co. Board from 1917 to 1924. He was instrumental in the purchase of Semple Stadium by the G.A.A. in 1910.
