SOMMY MALTER

The name "Sonny Maher" is known throughout Tipperary and beyond as one of the great Boherlahan and Tipperary hurlers.

Sonny's father, Jack won All-Ireland honours with Tubberadora in 1898 and his uncle, the legendary 'Big Mikey' was the captain of the Tubberardora teams of 1895–96–98, he also won All-Ireland medals in 1899 and 1900 with Horse and Jockey and Two-Mile-Borris.

Sonny's sons John, served as club officer for many years and co-wrote the Boherlahan/Dualla club history and Billy, who played on many successful parish teams and had the distinction of being club chairman in the historic county final winning year of 1996. The link continues to the present day. with Billy's son, David a vital member of todays team.

Sonny was a member of the 1941 county champions. Boherlahan defeated Eire Og-Annscarthy in the final, and he played for many years for the club, captaining the team in 1949, when Borrisoleigh won the Mid final after a replay, in what has been described as a Golden Age of Tipperary hurling. He won a Mid final in 1953, when Boherlahan defeated Sarsfields in the final.

He played full forward in the great Tipperary three-in- α -row All-Ireland teams of 1949-50-51 and won National League medals in 1949-50-52.

Boherlahan-Dualla GAA

In the early years of the association, the parish was represented by clubs such as Tubberadora, Suir View and Ballytarsna, all of whom won county honours with famed Tubberadora winning three All-Ireland Senior titles in four years, 1895, 1896 and 1898.

In 1912, the Boherlahan club was founded and from then until 1928 the club won 9 county finals and two All-Ireland, 1916 and 1925, under the captaincy of the great Johnny Leahy, whose name is honoured on the Mid Tipperary Senior hurling championship trophy. Incidently, Johnny Leahy became the first Tipperary man to receive the Liam McCarthy Cup in 1925. The clubs first Mid success was in 1913, and the club dominated the division for the next few years. The club affiliated to the South division in the twenties and early thirties, winning six South championships in a row from 1924.

After this great spell, lean times followed, a County Senior victory in 1941, captained by Philly O'Dwyer, and a Mid Senior win in 1953, being the highlights. In the early sixties, the present name of Boherlahan-Dualla was adopted. A County Minor hurling title in 1970, with stalwarts like Seamus Power and Jim Keane, and an Intermediate victory in 1981 which restored our senior status, brought us up to the nineties. In 1993, the County Minor hurling title was won for a second time, and the nucleus of this team and 1994 County U-21 hurling finalists, formed the backbone of the 1995 Mid Senior championship winning team and County finalists.

1996 will live long in the memories of parishioners as the renewal of an old rivalry with the great Toomevara, saw us come out on top, 1-16 to 2-12 as Boherlahan-Dualla once more added its name to the county role of honour. This team, managed by Martin O'Dwyer, Kieran Maher and Willie Joe Dwyer and Donagh O'Donnell (trainer) lined out; Phillip Ryan, William Hickey, TJ O'Dwyer, Tommy O'Dwyer, Scamus Hickey, Conor Gleeson, David Ryan, Michael Ferncombe, JJ McGrath, Ger Flanagan, Michael Murphy, Brian O'Dwyer, Liam Maher and Aidan Flanagan, added new pride to the famous old colours.

For many years the local field was situated in Gaile and hosted some great games included famous Mid Senior hurling finals featuring Thurles Sarsfield, Moycarkey and Thurles Kickhams. The present grounds were acquired in the early 1970's and with great voluntary help and support, the Sports complex, stand and facilities were developed to make Boherlahan Sportsfield the fine facility it is today.

Drom-Inch GAA Club was formed in 1887 and from 1934 it used what is currently the County Camogie pitch as its main grounds. In 1986 a committee was formed to cater for the ever expanding requirements of the club and a 7 acre site was purchased from John Egan. In 1987 work began in earnest in developing what is now the Ragg GAA Pitch and grounds which were officially opened on 13th May 1990. The Ragg pitch soon became one one of the busiest venues in Mid Tipperary due to its prime location, ease of access and good facilities. In 2003 a second development committee was formed to develop the Ragg grounds further so double-headers like today's Mid Final could be more comfortably accommodated with more modern facilities for both players and spectators.
