Profile of our Captain.

DROM-INCH CAPTAIN - EAMONN BUCKLEY

Drom/Inch captain for 2008 is 26 year old PE Teacher Eamonn Buckley. Like many of his team mates Eamonn stated out his hurling career under the tutelage of Paudi Butler in Inch N.S. Eamonn has the full set of county underage medals from U12 to U21 and has played in every single county final up along except at U12 level. Winning underage titles for the club brought him to the attention of the county selectors from a very young age. Eamonn captained Mid



Tipperary to victories in the Peadar Cummins (U14) in 1996 and Garda Cup (u16) in 1998 before making the Tipp minor team in 2000. His first piece of silverwear at county level came when he won a Munster U21 final in 2003 lining out at corner back. Eamonn was brought onto the Tipp senior panel in 2006 when Ken Hogan was in charge and in 2007 he made his competitive debut against Limerick. He won a National hurling league and Munster final medal with Tipperary in 2008 Eamonn is a PE teacher in Thurles CBS where he has been for the past three years and during that time he has coached the Harty, first years and Fitzgearld teams, winning back to back Rice Cup titles. At club level Eamonn has coached teams from U16 to U21 level Today is a great honour for Eamonn and his family. He has been a leader in the senior team from a very young age and this is his ninth year playing for the senior team, we hope to see his leadership and direction start from the square and ooze through to the entire team.

Profile of our Captain.

SARSFIELDS CAPTAIN - STEPHEN LILLIS

Stephen Lillis is a man with a lot of hurling experience having been through the mill with Durlas Og and Sarsfields.

A multiple medal winner with Durlas Og in his juvenile days, Stephen is a sweet striker of the ball and a man who is renowned for his reading of the game. His class comes to the fore time and again and he was delighted to have helped Sarsfields to the elusive county crown in 2005 in only his second year on the senior panel.



His brother John is also a member of the panel. Stephen has also represented Tipperary at minor, under 21 and senior level. He won Munster titles at both minor and under 21 levels but Kilkenny stopped Stephens attempts at All-Ireland honours in 04 and 06. This season he has already won his first Fitzgibbon Cup medal playing a significant role in W.I.T's victory over L.I.T in the final.

Stephen is honoured to be captain of Thurles Sarsfields in 2008 and would love to lift the Leahy Cup for his native parish.



Referees Profile: - An Reiteoir

The referee for today's Mid Senior Hurling Final is John Kelly from the Thurles KRF club. John is a well known referee not alone within this division, but all over the county. As a native of County Kildare, John's refereeing commenced mainly on the football fields. He has refereed football matches at all levels in this division including a number of Mid Senior Football Finals. In the last couple of years John became interested and got a flair

for the hurling game and soon came to the notice of those appointing referees for county senior hurling championships which resulted in him taking charge of a number of senior hurling matches in the other divisions.

This is Johns first Mid Senior Hurling Final and so we take this opportunity to extend to him and his officials our best wishes in today's final.

Looking back at Yester Years

Compiled by Bob Stakelum, President of the Mid Tipp Senior Board.

1. Seven clubs as constituted now have provided captains for All Ireland Senior Hurling Championship winning teams.

Thurles Sarsfields 10 - 1887, 1906, 1908, 1930, 1937, 1945, 1958, 1962, 1964, 1965.

Boherlahan/Dualla 5 - 1895, 1896, 1898, 1916, 1925.

Borrisoleigh 3 - 1950, 1951, 1989.

Moycarkey/Borris 2 - 1899, 1900.

Holycross/Ballycahill 2 - 1949, 1991.

Toomevara 2 - 1961, 2001.

Roscrea 1 - 1971.

Note: 1989 Captain Bobby Ryan was nominated by Loughmore/Castleiney.

- 2. From 1912 to 1931, all County Senior Hurling Championships were won by either Boherlahan or Toomevara with the exception of Moycarkey/Borris in 1926 and Thurles Sarsfields in 1929.
- 3. Thurles Sarsfields and Moycarkey/Borris won all Senior Hurling County titles from 1932 to 1940.

Moycarkey/Borris - 1932, 1933, 1934, 1937 and 1940.

Thurles Sarsfields - 1935, 1936, 1938 and 1939.

- 4. From 1902 to 1942 only four clubs won Senior County Hurling titles, Thurles Sarsfields, Boherlahan, Moycarkey/Borris and Toomevara. Eire Og/Annacarty broke the sequence in 1943 when they defeated Moycarkey in the final.
- 5. Rahealty was the first club to win a County Minor Hurling Championship (1953). Divisional selections or Thurles C.B.S. were previous winners.
- 6. The following were All Star winners from Mid Tipperary: Tommy Butler 1978, Declan Carr 1989, Eamon Corcoran 2001 and Eddie Enright 2001.
- 7. From 1908 until 1946 all Mid Senior Hurling titles were shared by Thurles Sarsfields, Moycarkey/Borris and Boherlahan with the exception of Clonoulty in 1929 and Killea/Castleiney in 1928.
- 8. The following from Mid Tipp refereed All Ireland Hurling Finals: John Joe Callanan Junior Hurling in 1929 and Senior Hurling in 1940. Phil Purcell Junior Hurling in 1946 and Senior Hurling in 1947. Bob Stakelum Senior Hurling 1955. John Ryan Under 21 Hurling final in 2007.
- The parishes that have produced teams that have won County Senior titles in both hurling and football are: Nenagh, Mullinahone, Loughmore/Castleiney, Moyne/Templetuohy, Kilruane and Thurles.
- 10. During the 1940's, seven clubs won Senior Hurling titles: Moycarkey/Borris 1940, Boherlahan/Dualla 1941, Thurles Sarsfields 1942, 1944, 1945 and 1946, Carrick Swans 1947, Holycross/Ballycahill 1948 and Borrisoleigh 1949.

This did not happen again until the 1980's when the winners were Roscrea 1980, Borrisoleigh 1981, 1983 and 1986, Kilruane 1985, Cappawhite 1987, Loughmore/Castleiney 1988 and Clonoulty/Rossmore 1989.




