

#### LATE MICK DEMPSEY, R.I.P.

Mick Dempsey, R.I.P., who passed to his eternal reward just 2 weeks ago today, was an outstanding goalkeeper with Kilsheelan back in the glorious years of the Club's history in the late 1920 and early 30's. He won two Co. Senior medals with the Club, one in 1930 and another in 1933. It must have been a great source of pride for him to see his son, Johnny, follow in his footsteps as a top-class goalkeeper, representing the County and winning 2 Co. Senior medals with Kilsheelan, like his father. The Dempsey family must, therefore, be unique in Kilsheelan football circles in that the 4 County title medals won by the Club are in the family.

Another son, Michael, also plays football with the Club. Mick's passing has broken a link with the past, which goes back to the foundation of the Club in 1925.
