Eire Og Annacarty

The Eire Og club has the proud tradition of being the only West Tipperary club since the formation of the division to win a county senior hurling title. They achieved that historic victory in 1943 when they defeated Moycarkey-Borris.

The following year Eire Og won their fourth consecutive West senior title. The 1950's were lean times with the dominance of Knockavilla Kickhams but in 1961 they combined with to-day's opponents, Cappawhite, and under the name St. Vincents won the divisional title. 1962 saw them take divisional title in No. 1 junior hurling and junior football. Two years later they had another memorable double with senior hurling and junior football titles. In 1966 the No. 2 junior went to Annacarty while in 1967 they took their sixth senior hurling title.

In 1973 the No. 2 junior hurling title was again captured, while 1974 was made memorable by the winning of the county junior football title.

The mid '70's saw the club without a senior team but the re-building was fast in progress. In 1976 they won the junior hurling title but failed in a replay to capture the county title.

CAPPAWHITE

Cappawhite who were runners-up to Sean Treacys in the divisional deciders of '78 and '79 are no strangers to the big day. In fact initially when the division was founded in 1930 Cappa' teamed up with Donohill to take the first ever West junior hurling title.

County honours first came to Cappawhite in 1942 when hurlers like Tommy Treacy, 'Rafferty' O'Neill, Bill O'Neill and Thomas Coughlan wore the singlet in their first junior county title. Back they came to take their second crown in 1948, but then they came on lean times and in the '50's Cappa' sought help from Solohead and under the name St. Nicholas's won the 1957 senior crown. 1962 saw Cappa' take the u/15 county championship while in 1961 they joined up with to-day's opponents, Eire Og under the name St. Vincents and took the divisional senior title. The junior side also took the championship that year. With some help from neighbours Glengar they won the senior hurling title in 1962, while '65 saw them take u/21 and minor county crowns. In 1977 Cappa' joined with Eire Og and won the county u/21 crown. They also took the junior county football title that same year. In 1977 & '78 while again combined with to-day's opposition they won West minor hurling titles, and in the latter year Cappa' took their first ever senior divisional football crown.

1930

In 1930 hurling was alive and well in Tipperary. It was the year that the county annexed the All Ireland hurling triple crown. The Western part of the Premier County was awake too, with the formation of a new divisional board. The first officers were :-
President: Rev. J. Moloney, C.C., Clonoulty;
Chairman: William O'Dwyer, M.C.C., Vice-Chairmen: Tim Gleeson, Sean Stapleton, Secretary: D.B English, Treasurer: W. O'Dwyer, N.T., Co. Board Reps: Mick Dargan, Tim Gleeson, P.F McGrath, Sean Stapleton.

Twenty three teams entered for the first championships and the winners were :- (Senior Hurling) Clonoulty (Runners-up) Solohead: (Junior Hurling) Cappawhite-Donohill (Runners-up) Knockavilla: (Junior Football) Knockavilla-Rossmore (Runners-up) Solohead.

A MID TITLE FOR CLONOULTY IN 1927

Clonoulty has the honour of being the only team from West Tipperary to win a Mid S.H title. They achieved that feat in 1927, three years before the West Board was formed. In the Mid final they defeated Moycarkey by 5-2 to 2-3.
