2012 KILLENAULE GAA CLUB

Cill Náile GAA Club situated in the parish of Killenaule/Moyglass founded in 1885 played one of its first hurling matches in Cork against Aughabulla. Predominantly a hurling club, football always comes secondary to our hurling aspirations. For most of our existence we enjoyed duel club status with separate affiliations, hurling and football. Three years ago County Board forced us to change to a single status club. Ironically we are now officially registered in Croke Park as Cumann Cill Náile Peil. Today as we contest a South Senior Football Final for the first time in our history, a position we never expected to be in or honestly never aspired to. 2012 to date has been a very successful year for our club as we find ourselves in three south finals and a county hurling league final.

This is no doubt due to the endeavour and commitment of our management teams and players. Senior football and senior hurling, Manager Joe O'Dwyer Selectors: Liam Sweeney, Pat Fennelly and Declan Fanning Minor Hurling Manager Thomas Shelley and his selectors Gerry Kennedy, Darragh Blake and Declan Fanning Junior B Manager Thomas Shelley and his selectors Paul Shelley and Frankie Kelly & Declan Fanning.

This success could also be attributed to decisions made early in the year as regards training and competitions and to the total commitment of our players and no doubt to our underage structures which continue to turn out first class players our commitment to schools coaching and to the huge support given by our club administrators

Looking back at our history in football we have had some success down through the years winning a South Junior A Football Final in 1982 and again in 1994 Junior B Football Final in 1961. Minor Football Final in 1963 joined with Drangan. Minor Football Final in 1977 joined with Mullinahone. U-21 A Football 1978 joined with Mullinahone.U-21 B Football 1993, 1998 & 2000.

In 1944 Killenaule won the Mid Tipperary Junior Football Title.

In 2004 Killenaule won its first Intermediate South Title and went on the same year to win County title thus bringing us up to Senior Football status which we have held onto since with the minimum of success.
