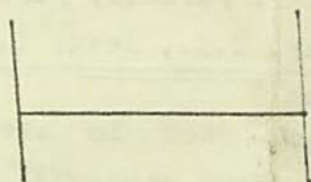

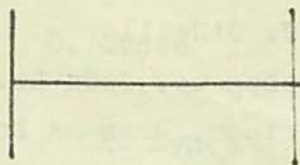

Arravale Rovers last won the Hennessy Cup in 1981 and have captured it four times in all. One of the Oldest clubs in the division records show that the Club won an All Ireland Football Final back in 1895. County Finals were won in 1896, 1899, 1909, 1911, and 1941. Quite a number of to-day's Club members have served the County both as players and administrators. Tom Twomey played in goal with the Tipperary Junior footballers defeated by Cork this year. Tony Maher a former minor and under 21 county player is on the present senior panel. Pat McCormack, Carl Lowry, Tom Ritchardson and Brendan Fogarty have also represented the County at senior level. Paul Landers is a former county minor hurler and footballer, Jerry Ring is of course West Board Secretary. Seamus O'Donoghue serves as a county senior football selector while Hugh Kennedy is Chairman of the County minor football board. Con O'Sullivan, Tom Twomey and Timmie Hennessy are current members of the referees panel.
