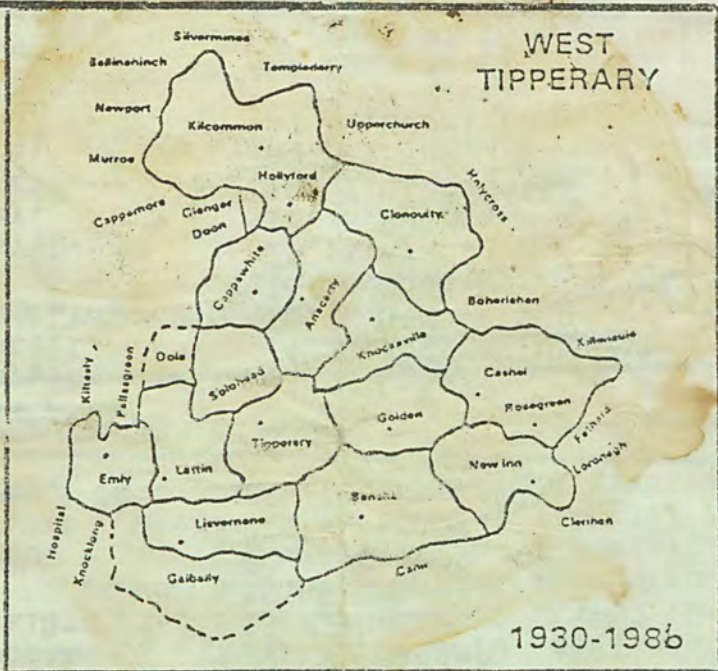

Arravale Rovers last won the Hennessy Cup in 1984. They won the Co. S.F.C. in 1986. The club is one of the oldest clubs in the Division, winning an All Ireland S.F.C. in 1895. Quite a number of to-day's club members have served the Division and the County as players and administrators. T.Toomey, P.McCormack and B.Fogarty played S.F. with Tipperary in 1986. D.Walsh, J.Lowry, T. Richardson, W.Crowe, C. Lowry, T.Meagher, P.Landers and W.Madden have also represented the County at various levels with distinction.

Hugh Kennedy is Chairman of the Co. Football Board and Jerry Ring is the current West Board Secretary.

The Golden club is also one of the oldest in the Division founded in 1885 while a club was formed in Kilfeacle in 1887. These two clubs came together in the mid 1940's. They have won Co. Junior Football honours in 1979 and Co. Intermediate F honours in 1982. Their only victory in the Hennessy Cup came when they joined with Rockwell Rvs. in 1980. They won Divisional M.F. titles in 1952, 1984, 1985. They contested the West S.H.C. Final against Eire Og earlier this year.

J.O'Connell, T.Leamy, E.Ryan, N.Fogarty, D. Fogarty, F.Ryan, M.O'Donnell and L.Sullivan have all worn the County colours in either Hurling or Football on many occasions with distinction.
