# Roscrea

## Ros Cré: The Wood of Crea.

Crea was the wife of Dála after whom the Slighe Dála was named. It ran from Tara to Ormond being one of the five great ancient roads of Ireland; Roscrea stands on an important junction of this route.

For Centuries before the advent of Christianity the town was the venue of Aonach Eile, i.e., the great fair of Ely O'Carroll. St Cronan, whose ancestors come from the area, set up his monastery c. 600 A.D. in a remote place called Sean Ross about a mile from the present town. Saddened to hear that some travellers failed to find him in his cell he resolved to establish a monastery near the main highway and so came to Roscrea proper. The Community here flourished and under the protection, and with the benevolence of the Prince of Ely prospered. The Book of Dimma, an 8th Century copy of the Gospels, with illustrations of the four Evangelists, was written in this Abbey. It is one of ten manuscripts extant in this country dating from before 1,000 A.D. Although attributed to Dimma Mac Naithi it was the work of many monks of St. Cronan's and so could more properly be called the "Book of Roscrea". The precious book together with its cumdach (Shrine c. 1150, a gift of Thadeus O'Carroll) may be seen in Trinity College. The original manuscript of the 'Annals of Roscrea' is lost but a 17th Century copy is preserved in the Royal Library at Brussels, as is another 17th Century copy of the third great literary work of the Monks, 'The Rule of Echtgus Ua Cuanáin'. Roscrea remained an independent diocese up to the latter part of the 12th Century and the beautiful Hiberno-Romanesque gable still standing was part of the Cathedral Church. The 10th Century Round Tower saved the monks on many an occasion from the plundering Norsemen (its present decapitated state is a result of a 1798 Insurgent using its height to shoot at the Castle Sentry. Not alone was the top removed but it was reduced from 80 feet to 60 feet in height).

In 942 the people of Ely and Ormond assembled for the great fair on June 29th. Attracted by stories of the great wealth a large army of the Norsemen intent on destroying and ravishing was completely routed by the Irish and their retreat back towards Limerick may still be traced from the place names that have survived.

Roscrea came early under the sway of the Anglo-Normans who built a substantial stronghold here in 1213. The Manor of Roscrea for centuries was a chief seat of a branch of the Butlers while the native chief of the Tuath (present Barony of Ikerrin)—Ua Meachair was allowed to remain, but under Norman control. The Prince of the territory, The O'Carroll, carried on an intermittent struggle to retain his ancient rights. The Tower keep and John's Castle date back to the 13th Century. (In the 17th Century Anthony Hamilton, author of the celebrated "Memoirs of the Count De Gramont" was born here). The Franciscan Friary was a late 15th Century Foundation again aided by O'Carroll.

In 1665 Roscrea had 106 houses (Hearth-money Records). By 1841 the total population of Roscrea Parish was over 9,000. The Great Hunger hit hard but the real scourge of Roscrea from 1850 to 1950 was emigration although the population increase of 45% in the 1901—1961 period is among the highest in the Country.

Roscrea's situation on the main Dublin-Limerick Coach road helped its trade growth in the 18th and 19th Centuries when many varied industries flourished in the area. These included 900 weavers and the trades of tanning, brewing, distilling, brogue-making, nailing and chandlery prospered up to the introduction of machinery and the railways. Roscrea Whiskey (Birches) was very famous but local events and Fr. Mathew sealed its fate and in 1850 the distillery was up for auction.

"Perhaps no other church ruin in Ireland is so attractive in site, completeness, interesting detail and appearance as that of Monaincha". (H. G. Leask). Now called simply "The Holy Island" this hallowed retreat founded in the sixth Century by St. Canice of Aghaboe and renowned as a place of pilgrimage for over a thousand years offers the same peace and spiritual solitude as experienced by our ancestors. The living monastic tradition of Roscrea is carried on by the Cistercians of Mt. St. Joseph.

So when the crowds congregate in Roscrea for Fleadh na Mumhan we can truly say that they are gathering for Aonach Eile inaugurated over fifteen hundred years ago.

## What to see!

**Monaincha Abbey:** 2 miles S.E. of Roscrea. 12th Century Hiberno-Romanesque Church and Cross.

**Church Street:** 10th Century Round Tower; 12th Century West Gable of Cathedral Church of St. Cronan and Cross. Church of Ireland built 1812—interior recently decorated.

**Castle Street:** 13th Century Castle with early 18th Century Damer House with beautiful Queen Anne staircase.

**Abbey Street:** Late 15th Century Franciscan Friary. Roman Catholic Church—Gothic—commenced 1844, completed 1866.

**Cistercian Abbey:** 2½ miles West on Shinrone Road.

**Leap Castle:** 5 miles N.W. on Kinnitty Road. Very famous Ghost — only known ghost which smells.

**Ballinakill Castle and Bawn:** 3 miles S.W., off Limerick Road. Birthplace of Count Walter Butler.

**Standing Stones of Timoney and Cullaun:** About 4 miles East, off the Errill Road. 300 stones scattered over 100 acres, dating from Bronze Age.

**Gloster:** Magnificent 17th Century House with beautiful Italian Gardens. Former home of Lloyds, it is now a Salesian Convent. 5 miles N.W., on Birr Road.

A very good picture of the town and its environs may be had from Carrick Hill (one mile S.)


