18th century Cashel rental

Archbishop Michael Cox was the Protestant Archbishop of Cashel from 1754 to 1779, when he died at Castletown, county Kilkenny. He was succeeded by Charles Agar, who remained until 1801, when he was appointed Archbishop of Dublin. He was created Earl of Normanton in 1806.

The Normanton papers were deposited in the Hampshire Record Office at Winchester in England. They contain rentals for the See lands of the Diocese of Cashel and Emly. Amongst the papers for Cashel is the following rental (21M57, Box 5).

Rents received August 21st 1779 from Mr. Richard Lockwood as a defective memorial but the best he could procure.
